Congregational Reading of Compilation of The Narrative

:1 Now it came to pass after these things that God tested Abraham, and said to him, “Abraham!” and he said, “Here I am.” :2 Then He said, “Take now your son, your only son Isaac, whom you love, and go to the land of Moriah, and offer him there as a burnt offering on one of the mountains of which I shall tell you.” :3 So Abraham rose early in the morning and saddled his donkey, and took two young men with him, and Isaac his son; and he split the wood for the burnt offering, and arose and went to the place of which God had told him. :4 Then on the third day Abraham lifted his eyes and saw the place afar off. 5 And Abraham said to his young men, :5 “Stay here with the donkey; the lad and I will go yonder and worship, and we will come back to you.” So Abraham took the wood of the burnt offering and laid it on Isaac his son; :6 And he took the fire in his hand, and a knife, and the two of them went together. 7 But Isaac spoke to Abraham his father and said, “My father!” :7 And he said, “Here I am, my son.” Then he said, “Look, the fire and the wood, but where is the lamb for the burnt offering?” :8 And Abraham said, “My son, God will provide for Himself the lamb. :9 Now the Lord spoke to Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt, saying, “This month shall be your beginning of months; it shall be the first month of the year to you. :10 Speak to all the congregation of Israel, saying: “On the tenth of this month every man shall take for himself a lamb, :11 Your lamb shall be without spot or blemish, a male of the first year. :12 “For I will pass through the land of Egypt on that night, and will strike all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt - I will execute judgment upon them: I am the Lord. :13 Now the blood from your Lamb shall be a sign for you on your house where you are and when I see the blood of the Lamb, I will pass over you; :14 and the plague shall not be upon you - to destroy you when I strike the land of Egypt for their sins. :15 Now in the land of Judea, coming to the people was a man named John. He preached not himself but that the Christ was to come. :16 And John seeing Jesus on the next day coming toward him, said, “Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world! :17 For thus spoke the Prophet saying; “He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed. :18 All we like sheep have gone astray; We have turned, every one, to his own way; And the Lord has

laid on Him the iniquity of us all. :19 He was oppressed and He was afflicted, Yet He opened not His mouth; He was led as a lamb to the slaughter, And as a sheep before its shearers is silent, So He opened not His mouth.” :20 So then Pilate took Jesus and scourged Him and the soldiers twisted a crown of thorns and put it on His head, :21 and they put on Him a purple robe. Then they said, “Hail, King of the Jews!” And they struck Him with their hands. :22 Now the Jewish leadership answered and said, “We have a law, and according to our law Jesus ought to die, because He declares Himself to be the Son of God.” :23 Thus they cried out, “Away with Him, away with Him! Crucify Him!” :24 And He, bearing His cross, went out to a place called “the Place of a Skull”, which is called in Hebrew, Golgotha, Calvary :25 And there they crucified Jesus, and two others with Him, one on either side, and Jesus in the center. :26 Now Pilate wrote a title and put it on His cross. And the writing was: **JESUS OF NAZARETH, THE KING OF THE JEWS.** :27 Now before the Feast of the Passover should end, Jesus knowing that His hour had come that He should depart out of this world back to the Father, having loved His own who were in the world, He loved them unto the end. :28 So when Jesus had received the sour wine, He said, “It is finished!” And bowing His head, He released His spirit. :29 Now some of His followers took the body of Jesus down from the cross and bound it in strips of linen with the spices, as the custom of the Jews is to bury. :30 Now in the place where He was crucified there was a garden, and in the midst of the garden a new tomb in which no one had yet been laid. :31 So there they laid the body of Jesus.
