Philippians 2:1-4

Philippians 2:1-4

Therefore if there is any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any affection and mercy, 2 fulfill my joy by being like-minded, (1) having the same love, (2) being of one accord, (3) of one mind. 3 Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself. 4 Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others.

In the words of that immortal philosopher, Tina Turner, When she asked - "What's Love Got to Do With It?"

The Answer is – it has everything to do with it!

Ephesians 4:14-15

that we should no longer be children, tossed to and fro and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of men, in the cunning craftiness of deceitful plotting, 15 but, speaking the truth in love, may grow up in all things into Him who is the head, even Christ.

Because according to the Bible, Love came down in human flesh and lived in this world - convicting us of sin, pointing us to His cross, showing us the way of salvation.

1a.) A Christ centered humility softens our hearts

vs. 1-2a

Therefore if there is any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any affection, and mercy, 2 fulfill my joy by being like-minded,

because we have been created by God to experience;

consolation, rest, comfort, persistent love, fellowship bonded partnership, affection intestinal mercy, merciful acts

these attributes being present, creates a like-mindedness,

1b.) A Christ centered humility causes us to care vs. 2b

Philippians 2:1-4

(1) having the same love, (2) being of one accord, (3) of one mind

!!! There is a Grand Assumption Here !!!

Notice, none of these actions or qualities or virtues are to be done in a vacuum. Christianity is a public faith because the Christian is a social being.

John 18:19 NIV

The high priest questioned Jesus about his disciples and his teaching. :20 "I have spoken openly to the world, I always taught in synagogues or at the temple, where all the Jews come together. I said nothing in secret.

Verse 2b

(1) **Having** the **same** - - that is **Having** the same Holy Spirit that lives inside the Christian is the very source for our unity. It is through the Holy Spirit that we are members of the Body of Christ, the Church united.

The Significance of One Word in the Bible Matters!

Have or Having

Ephesians 4:11-13a

And He Himself (Jesus) gave some (by the HS) to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, 12 for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, and for the edifying of the body of Christ, 13 till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God,

But How Does God Do This in Our Lives?

John 14:15-18

"If you love Me, keep My commandments. 16 And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever 17 the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you. 18 I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you.

(note here that the trinity is represented)

Colossians 1:27

To them (the gentile world) God willed to make known what are the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles: which is **Christ in you**, the **hope** (the firm reality) of glory.

Romans 8:16

The Spirit Himself bears witness (God gives testimony) with to our spirit that we are children of God,

the **same love**, = The **same love** (meaning) it's is the same love that God shows toward you and I. (we cannot truly love other people until we know what God's love is for us)

John 13:34-35

A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another. 35 By this all contacts will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another."

This "Christ-centered humility" causes us to care for others.

Being of one accord, = Joined at the Soul or Co-Linked or Interdependent. There are no spiritual Lone Rangers in the church of Jesus Christ.

of one mind. = to think the same thoughts at the same time about the same topic. (a company's or a team's dream come true) – those who do will arrive at the same point at the same moment for the same reason.

Psalm 133:1

Behold, how good and how pleasant it is For brethren to dwell together in unity!

Being "brethren" is the qualifier, to "dwell together" is their new nature, and the result is "unity"

So What Does That Look Like?

1 Corinthians 1:10

Now I plead with you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment.

We saw an unusual display of God's power here A couple of Wednesday nights ago. It was God at work.

Keep in mind that what I am going to tell you took place in a room of a couple thousand people. After our time of communion and worship, we paused and I asked the people to "shout out a verses or passage that might encourage all of us" well before the night was over, at four different times, and through eight different people, - they shouted out the exact same verses at the exact same time in perfect stereo, even the exact same bible version.

1c.) A Christ centered life keeps us on target

vs. 3

What is The Target(s) that We're Focused On?

It's the debasement of my self, it's me willfully removing myself from the front of the line.

Let nothing be done through (1) selfish ambition or (2) conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself

This is Perhaps the **Single Most Damaging Cancer** Within Any Church; When Christians fail at keeping themselves "Christ-Centered" in Life.

selfish ambition:

to use a veiled motive. To use intrigue, trickery, or scheming. To plot a course that results in self recognition. an ego-centric, self-absorbed, self-love.

James 3:13-16

Who is wise and understanding among you? Let him show by good conduct that his works are done in the meekness of wisdom. **14** But if you have bitter envy and self-seeking in your hearts, do not boast and lie against the truth. **15** This wisdom does not descend from above, but is earthly, sensual, demonic. **16** For where envy and self-seeking exist, confusion and every evil thing are there.

When we forget that Jesus Christ is Listening and

Watching, We gravitate toward "Self-Counsel" Self-Advice. We Actually Enthrone Ourselves. It's this "Self Promotion" that is Native to Our Fallen Nature. – it's a fatal move.

Conceit

kenodoxia, ken-od-ox-ee´-ah; an empty glory, a false or manmade glory. An arranged, manipulated glory. The glory of this world. (a Disney, Universal Studio's kinda glory)

The Picture That Paul's Words Paint

Are powerful and graphic to the Philippians.

1 Corinthians 9:24-25

Do you not know that those who run in a race all run, but one receives the prize? Run in such a way that you may obtain it. **25** And everyone who competes for the prize is temperate in all things. Now they do it to obtain a **perishable** crown (a laurel wreath), but we for an **imperishable** crown (of gold).

lowliness: tapeinophrosune, *tap-i-nof-ros-oo´-nay;* base humiliation of the mind, true modesty, humbleness of mind, **a man who himself is a stranger to his thoughts.** loneliness of mind.

The moment you think that you are humble is the moment that you are anything but. - Jack

We can hide behind words, and the meaning

of a word can be twisted.

Actions are all together different – actions reveal the truth.

Question to All; How do you know God loves you?

You can only know that by His actions. What action has He taken to show you that He loves you?

Romans 5:8

But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Verse 3b

let each esteem others **better** than himself

esteem: hJge÷omai hegeomai, hayg-eh'-om-ahee; to approach another with a high value of them, to consider, account, to judge worthy of. To extend the best

toward another.

1 Corinthians 13:4-8 AMP

Love suffers long and is kind; Love does not envy; Love does not parade itself, is not puffed up; 5
Love does not behave rudely, Love does not seek its own, is not provoked, Love thinks no evil; 6
Love does not rejoice in iniquity, but rejoices in the truth; 7 Love bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, Love endures all things. :8 Love never fails.

1d.) A Christ centered life opens up our eyes vs. 4

Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others.

This is exactly the model that Jesus showed us. If the eternal God came to serve mankind with His life, how much more are we to be willing to do the same for those whom He loves?

John 13:12-15

So when He had washed their feet, taken His garments, and sat down again, He said to them, "Do you know what I have done to you? 13 You call Me Teacher and Lord, and you say well, for so I am.

14 If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet. 15 For I have given you an example, that you should do as I have done to you.

A Jack Observation:

Only after we wake up and realize that Jesus Christ is looking out for us, that He has promised to take care of us, we needn't any longer have to focus on what's good for us or what's in it for me - - because we have committed ourselves to Christ, we can put our passion and effort into loving others because we are secure and settled ourselves.

For an unbeliever of this world it is all about him being first, others second and God in a deliberate last.

The exact opposite is true for the redeemed heart and mind. The Christian is all about God being first, others second and ourselves a deliberate last.

look out "not" skop'e-o, *skop-eh'-o;* to take aim at **(not yourself)** or focus upon, **(not yourself)** to gaze or wonder at **(not yourself)** – to stare **(not at yourself)**.

The Ministry of Others

The Chinese Evangelist, Watchmen Nee tells of an encounter

he had with a man who had a rice paddy terrace in inland china. Each day the man would go and flood his fields with water to promote the growth of his rice. But he noticed that later in the day his crops were dry and the water gone. He discovered

that the neighboring farmer below his fields would secretly drain the water into his own field leaving his dry. At first the man ignored this act of robbery but as time went on he could not produce enough rice to feed his family. He became bitter and angry and determined to confront his unlawful neighbor. Before he did the man went and talked to the elders of his church. They prayed with him and gave him scripture and encouraged him that God would tell him what to do. So as the man made his way back home, an idea came rushing into his mind. He remembered what they had told him, what Jesus had said in the Gospel, "Bless those who curse you and do good to those who use you" Just then he knew exactly what to do and on the next day, before he flooded his fields as he had always done, he made sure that his neighbor's field was flooded first. After three days of this, the unlawful neighbor came to him and said "Why are you doing this to me? I have been stealing your water and I have been expecting a confrontation with you, yet you have done this good to me." The man replied; "The Jesus of the Bible told me to do this to you." And within three months this unlawful neighbor became a follower of Jesus Christ!

This is Uniquely Christian; "to approach another with a high value of them."

How do we go about putting others first?

First, we need to ask God to take us out of the line-up. Second we must confess that we do not have it within us to love like Jesus, we need the Holy Spirit's power for that. Third, we need to practice the heart of Christ toward others – "this is what Jesus has done for me – I now choose to do this for you for Jesus' sake!
