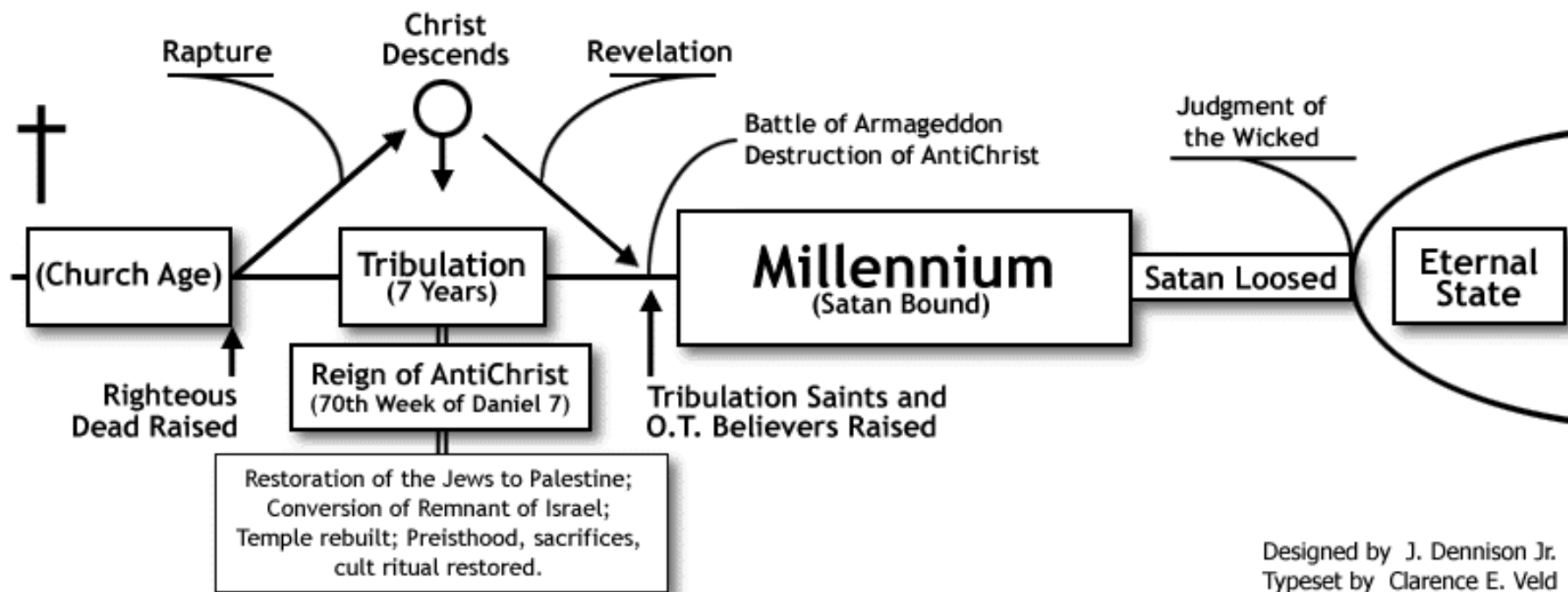


# ARRIVING

**1** Why do the nations rage, and the people plot a vain thing? **2** The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against the Lord and against His Anointed, saying, **3** “Let us break Their bonds in pieces and cast away Their cords from us.” **4** He who sits in the heavens shall laugh; the Lord shall hold them in derision. **5** Then He shall speak to them in His wrath, and distress them in His deep displeasure: ...

... **20** And pray that your flight may not be in winter or on the Sabbath. **21** For then there will be great tribulation, such as has not been since the beginning of the world until this time, no, nor ever shall be. **22** And unless those days were shortened, no flesh would be saved; but for the elect's sake those days will be shortened. **23** "Then if anyone says to you, "Look, here is the Christ!" or 'There!' do not believe it. **24** For false christs and false prophets will rise and show ...

... great signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect. **25** See, I have told you beforehand. **26** “Therefore if they say to you, ‘Look, He is in the desert!’ do not go out; or ‘Look, He is in the inner rooms!’ do not believe it. **27** For as the lightning comes from the east and flashes to the west, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be. **28** For wherever the carcass is, there the eagles will be gathered together.
