Matthew 5:17-18

"Do not think that I came to destroy the Law or the Prophets. I did not come to destroy but to fulfill. **18** For assuredly, I say to you, till heaven and earth pass away, one jot or one tittle will by no means pass from the law till all is fulfilled.

Jesus Christ Himself validates the integrity of the Bible.

(the Bible is God's medium / conduit / vehicle by which God has communication to the world & to an individual)

Isaiah 7:14

Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son, and shall call His name Immanuel.

Matthew 1:23

The Pharisees remained unconvinced of Jesus' claims

about Himself, despite His having just cured a demon-possessed man who was both blind and mute. Shortly after the Pharisees accused Jesus of driving out demons by the power of Satan, they said to Him, "Teacher, we want to see a sign from you."

Matthew 12:31-32

"Therefore I say to you, every sin and blasphemy will be forgiven men, but the blasphemy against the Spirit will not be forgiven men. **32** Anyone who speaks a word against the Son of Man, it will be forgiven him; but whoever speaks against the Holy Spirit, it will not be forgiven him, either in this age or in the age to come.

This is The Unforgivable Sin

Jesus was probably crucified on a Friday (Mark 15:42). According to the standard reckoning, Jesus died at about 3:00 PM (Matthew 27:46) on Friday (day 1). He remained dead for all of Saturday (day 2) and rose from the dead early on Sunday morning (day 3).

The Role of Christian Missionaries in the abolition of the Sati custom in India.

Dr. Ameeta Singh Professor of History Govt. Maharani Laxmi Bai Girls PG (Auto) College, Bhopal Madhya Pradesh

"The abolition of Sati in 1829 owes much to the efforts of the Christian missionaries. William Carey of Baptist missionary was the first man who led the campaign for a abolishing the sati custom in Calcutta. They worked against the British government, which was hesitant to take any action against this custom. They sent investigators collected data , compiled statistics of the victims, and they preached and published books and pamphlets against the rite, and thus helped to create in Britain an anti Sati public opinion. These works forced British parliament to prohibit this practice. This article is an attempt to analyze the e role of missionaries in abolition of Sati."
