For a minute, I want you to put away any thoughts as to whether you are a good person or bad, whether you think God loves you or hates you, whether you are following Him or not... I want you to ask yourself, do I even know Him?

Ever try and help a little kid that doesn't know you? Disneyland <u>stranger danger</u>.

God issues His own challenge... who can you compare me to?

- From the stars in the sky to the very hairs on your head or freckles on your face, not one is missing.
- God is the one who formed you in your mother's womb, skillfully, fearfully made. *He knows you but do you know Him?*

Daniel 4:35 & 37 All the inhabitants of the earth *are* reputed as nothing; He does according to His will in the army of heaven And *among* the inhabitants of the earth. No one can restrain His hand Or say to Him, "What have You done?"

Now I, Nebuchadnezzar, praise and extol and honor the King of heaven, all of whose works *are* truth, and His ways justice. And those who walk in pride He is able to put down.

ommercial... good enough is not good enough.

I'm not asking you to like Jesus, not to agree with Jesus, but I'm asking: have you decided to follow Jesus?

Numb limb...

*Those who... means not everyone does.

Wait: to linger patiently

Wait on the Lord? WHY?

He will renew your strength

Means two things...

- **1.** It's normal to run out of strength
- **2.** You don't have to run on empty all the time. You will not only make it through, you rise above. You will soar over the insanity

What's the trick to having a steadfast heart... an immovable mind?

Your value system cannot be **gain**, **acceptance**, **entertainment** or **anger**... it must be Jesus! You must have an eternal perspective.

ROPE ILLUSTRATON

Isaiah 26:3 You will keep *him* in perfect peace, *whose* mind *is* stayed *on You*, because he trusts in You.

Stayed: Lean, rest, lean against, braced by

Trusts: to have bold confidence, to be secure or safe.

Keep him: guard, watch over you..

In perfect peace: completeness, safety, contentment. Steadfastness... lack of turmoil

(Peace be still)

Hebrews 6:19 This hope we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and steadfast...

Turn the telescope around – Magnify the Lord

1. Our Understanding of Who King Jesus is would be Biblically accurate and not minimized in any way

2. We would be ok with His timing... we would learn or continue to "wait" on the Lord.
