Statement of Textual Summation and Theme

Matthew 2:1-2

Now after Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea in the days of Herod the king, behold, wise men from the East came to Jerusalem, **2** saying, "Where is He who has been born King of the Jews? For we have seen His star in the East and have come to worship Him."

There is much in the way of tradition and lore

about these Wise Men. Tradition tells us that they came from Iraq. That they had been schooled in the ways of Daniel of old. That they knew of or about the coming of the Messiah by the Teachings and Studies of the Prophet Daniel.

We've heard that there were (3) three Wisemen (?) - we don't know that.

We're heard that they were (3) three kings also (?)
- we don't know that either.

But What We Do Know is What The Bible Has to Say.

For Nearly Two Thousand Years,

the celebration and acknowledgement of Christmas has been Part of the Christian Culture Around the World.

The "Acknowledgment" of the Birth of Jesus Christ

is something that is wonderfully "technical" when you look into the history of it.

When You Consider...

The **Promise** of His Birth, His **Actual** Birth Itself, and the **Effects** of His Birth, Each of These Things are an **Undeniable Fact**.

1.) We'd have to neglect the biblical accounts

The Wise Men of Old Were Drawn to Where Jesus was, and for The Reason Jesus was...

Matthew 2:2

"Where is He who has been born King of the Jews?
(#1) - For we've seen His star in the East and (#2) - we've come to worship Him."

By the way of the sea, beyond the Jordan, In Galilee of the Gentiles. **2** The people who walked in darkness Have seen a great light; Those who dwelt in the land of the shadow of death, Upon them a light has shined.

Titus 1:2

The truth of God gives us confidence of eternal life, which God has **promised** us before the world began—for God cannot lie.

You Can Define "Promise" with One Word - Jesus!

Jesus "empowered" the "promises" of the Bible by doing what was promised in the Bible!

Matt. 4:23-25

And Jesus went about all Galilee, **teaching** in their synagogues, **preaching** the gospel of the kingdom, and **healing** all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease among the people. **:24** Then His fame went throughout all Syria; and they brought to Him all sick people who were afflicted with various diseases...and torments, and those who were demon-possessed, epileptics, and paralytics; and He **healed** them. **:25** Great multitudes followed Him—from Galilee, and *from* Decapolis, Jerusalem, Judea, and beyond the Jordan.

Matt. 14:14-16

And when Jesus went out He saw a great multitude; and He was moved with compassion for them, and healed their sick. :15 When it was evening, His disciples came to Him, saying, "This is a deserted place, and the hour is already late. Send the multitudes away, that they may go into the villages and buy themselves food." :16 But Jesus said to them, "They do not need to go away. You give them something to eat."

My Favorite Christmas Verse of All

1 Timothy 3:16

And without controversy *(unable to refute this)* great is the mystery of godliness:
God was manifested *(appeared)* in the flesh, was Justified in the Spirit,
Seen by angels, Preached among the Gentiles, Believed on in the world,
Received up in glory.

!! It's That Word "Seen" that Grabs Me Every Time!!

Seen: 3700. ὀπτάνομαι optanomai, op-tan´-om-ahee,
To gaze, being transfixed, to be wide eyed, be holding that which is something remarkable; an earnest, a continued inspection; a watching, a peering into, to lean into see.

Something Happened in that Manger Scene and people have been blessed ever since!

2.) We'd have to reject the historical data

WE'D HAVE TO REJECT THE HISTORICAL DATA

2a.) The evidence is this - history itself

John 21:24-25

This is the disciple who testifies of these things, and wrote these things; and we know that his testimony is true. **:25** And there are also many other things that Jesus did, which if they were written one by one, I suppose that even the world itself could not contain the books that would be written. Amen.

WE'D HAVE TO REJECT THE HISTORICAL DATA

2b.) The evidence is this - recorded eyewitness accounts

1John 1:1

That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon, and our hands have handled, concerning the Word of life— 2 the life was manifested, and we have seen, and bear witness, and declare to you that eternal life which was with the Father and was manifested to us— 3 that which we have seen and heard we declare to you, that you also may have fellowship with us; and truly our fellowship *is* with the Father and with His Son Jesus Christ. 4 And these things we write to you that your joy may be full.

Luke 2:7-14

And she brought forth her firstborn Son, and wrapped Him in swaddling cloths, and laid Him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn. :8 \(\)

2c.) The evidence is this - societal / cultural change

The undisputed fact is, no single individual on earth, throughout history as given more, done more, to help more than the Christian - no one!

Because The Christian Believes That The Christmas Message is Real.

1 John 3:15-16

Whoever **hates** his brother is a **murderer**, and you know that no murderer has eternal life abiding in him. (goes to heaven) :16 By this we know love, because He laid down His life for us. And we also ought to lay down *our* lives for the brethren. 17 But whoever has this world's goods, and sees his brother in need, and shuts up his heart from him, how does the love of God abide in him?

(answer - it doesn't)

By The Way, What Year is It?

Even our very date of the year is based upon Jesus' life.

Acts 17:5

But the Jews who were not persuaded, becoming envious, took some of the evil men from the marketplace, and gathering a mob, set all the city in an uproar and attacked the house of Jason, and sought to bring them out to the people. 6 But when they did not find them, they dragged Jason and some brethren to the rulers of the city, crying out, "These who have turned the world upside down have come here too.

"The Life, Education, Mission, and Passion of Saul of Tarsus.

Saul of Tarsus was a Notable among Those in the First Century. He was a devoted Jew and prosecutor against Christianity and ministry of Jesus Christ

Phil. 3:7

But what things were gain to me, these I have counted loss for Christ. **8** Yet indeed I also count all things loss for the excellence of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them as rubbish, that I may gain Christ **9** and be found in Him, not having my own righteousness, which *is* from the law, but that which *is* through faith in Christ, the righteousness which is from God by faith;
