The Pharisee's Challenged Authority, He Challenged Theirs !

#### Luke 20:1-8

Now it happened on one of those days, as He taught the people in the temple and preached the gospel, *that* the chief priests and the scribes, together with the elders, confronted *Him* :2 and spoke to Him, saying, "Tell us, by what authority are You doing these things? Or who is he who gave You this authority?" :3 But He answered and said to them, "I also will ask you one thing, and answer Me: :4 The baptism of John—was it from heaven or from men?" :5 ¶ And they reasoned among themselves, saying, "If we say, "From heaven,' He will say, 'Why then did you not believe him?' :6 But if we say, "From men,' all the people will stone us, for they are persuaded that John was a prophet." :7 So they answered that they did not know where *it was* from. :8 And Jesus said to them, "Neither will I tell you by what authority I do these things."

## Jesus Confronted Israel's Idle Shepherds

Luke 20:9-16

**19** Then He began to tell the people this parable: "A certain man planted a vineyard, leased it to vinedressers, and went into a far country for a long time. **10** Now at vintage-time he sent a servant to the vinedressers, that they might give him some of the fruit of the vineyard. But the vinedressers beat him and sent *him* away empty-handed. **11** Again he sent another servant; and they beat him also, treated *him* shamefully, and sent *him* away empty-handed. **12** And again he sent a third; and they wounded him also and cast *him* out. **13** "Then the owner of the vineyard said, 'What shall I do? I will send my beloved son. Probably they will respect *him* when they see him.' **14** But when the vinedressers saw him, they reasoned among themselves, saying, "This is the heir. Come, let us kill him, that the inheritance may be ours.' **15** So they cast him out of the vineyard and killed *him*. Therefore what will the owner of the vineyard do to them? **16** He will come and destroy those vinedressers and give the vineyard to others." And when they heard *it* they said, "Certainly not!"

## Jesus' Wisdom Was Overwhelming

Luke 20:20-26

So they watched *Him,* and sent spies who pretended to be righteous, that they might seize on His words, in order to deliver Him to the power and the authority of the governor. **:21** Then they asked Him, saying, "Teacher, we know that You say and teach rightly, and You do not show personal favoritism, but teach the way of God in truth: **:22** Is it lawful for us to pay taxes to Caesar or not?" **:23** But He perceived their craftiness, and said to them, "Why do you test Me? **:24** Show Me a denarius. Whose image and inscription does it have?" ¶ They answered and said, "Caesar's." **:25** And He said to them, "Render therefore to Caesar the things that are Caesar's, and to God the things that are God's." **:26** But they could not catch Him in His words in the presence of the people. And they marveled at His answer and kept silent.

## Jesus Exposed The Hypocrisy of the Religionist

Luke 20:45-47

Then, in the hearing of all the people, He said to His disciples, **:46** "Beware of the scribes, who desire to go around in long robes, love greetings in the marketplaces, the best seats in the synagogues, and the best places at feasts, **:47** who devour widows' houses, and for a pretense make long prayers. These will receive greater condemnation."

#### IT COULD HAVE BEEN BECAUSE

Luke 21:7-13

So they asked Him, saying, "Teacher, but when will these things be? And what sign *will* there be when these things are about to take place?" **:8** And He said: "Take heed that you not be deceived. For many will come in My name, saying, 'I am *He*,' and, 'The time has drawn near.' Therefore do not go after them. **:9** But when you hear of wars and commotions, do not be terrified; for these things must come to pass first, but the end *will not come* immediately." **:10** Then He said to them, "Nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. **:11** And there will be great earthquakes in various places, and famines and pestilences; and there will be fearful sights and great signs from heaven. **:12** But before all these things, they will lay their hands on you and persecute *you*, delivering *you* up to the synagogues and prisons. You will be brought before kings and rulers for My name's sake. **:13** But it will turn out for you as an occasion for testimony.

Then He took the cup, and gave thanks, and said, "Take this and divide *it* among yourselves; **:18** for I say to you, I will not drink of the fruit of the vine until the kingdom of God comes." **:19** And He took bread, gave thanks and broke *it*, and gave *it* to them, saying, "This is My body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of Me." **:20** Likewise He also *took* the cup after supper, saying, "This cup *is* the new covenant in My blood, which is shed for you.
