Colossians 1:9-14

Colossians 1:9-14

For this reason we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to ask that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; :10 that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing *Him*, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God; :11 strengthened with all might, according to His glorious power, for all patience and longsuffering with joy; :12 giving thanks to the Father who has qualified us to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in the light. :13 He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed *us* into the kingdom of the Son of His love, :14 in whom we have redemption through His blood, even the forgiveness of sins.

If in these Series of Studies

a message can cause you to reconsider a divorce... The Only **Divorce** that Should be Taking Place in Our Lives, Is the **Divorcing** of our own agendas and the **Adoption** of God's perfect plan...

And an Overt Act of Obedience To His Word.

Matthew 7:20 - Luke 6:46

:20 Therefore by their fruits you will know them. :21 "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven.... Luke 6:46 "But why do you call Me 'Lord, Lord,' and not do the things which I say?

this has been my personal observation

In 20 years of being a pastor and in 30 years of being married and In 33 years of being a Christian I have never heard yet someone say... "I am so glad I got a divorce. Divorce has been a wonderful thing." – but I do hear, "we should have made it work"

AND WHAT AN ABORTION IS TO A CHILD, DIVORCE IS TO A MARRIAGE.

Why?

Because marriage is a sacred, divine institution, It's a covenantal agreement, between God, a man and a woman as husband and wife and it works !

Why?

Matthew 19:5-6

"For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh'? **:6** So then, they are no longer two but one flesh. Therefore what God has joined together, let not man separate."

Last Week We Looked at... BEING A CHRISTIAN IN THE MIDST OF A DIVORCE

- 1.) Seek every Biblical directive first

2 Corinthians 5:20-21

Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore *you* on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God. **:21** For He made Him who knew no sin *to be* sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

Ephesians 4:32

And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you.

BEING A CHRISTIAN AND SURVIVING A DIVORCE

1.) Healing – you will require time and effort to heal

let's be honest,

(each of them will display that pain in varying ways for the rest of their lives)

Human Desire Will Rival the Will of God

2 Corinthians 10:5

casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ,

A Warning Here:

You must decide now if you're going to play the (victim card) the victim card sounds like this... *"she really hurt me."* "he was cheating on me" "he never loved me" "*I never loved him*"

those words can only make you feel better for about 60 seconds – that's why you have to keep repeating them...

Step 1 - Get On With It Take the pain to Jesus and have a good cry. When you're done leave it with Him there.

1 Peter 5:7 casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you. **Psalm 107:20** He sent His word and healed them, And delivered *them* from their destructions.

Consume The Books of Psalms & Proverbs

2.) Focusing – you will need to redirect your attention

a divorce just doesn't happen. It may feel like it does, but there were signs and indicators...

But Ever Since That News Came you've been emotionally ravaged

Romans 12:17-19

Do not repay anyone evil for evil. Be careful to do what is right in the eyes of everybody. **:18** If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone. **:19** Do not take revenge, my friends, but leave room for God's wrath, for it is written: "It is mine to avenge; I will repay," says the Lord.

Redirect/focusing on defending your children

(we must enter into the "momma bear" mode)

if your spouse/the mom or dad is leaving the family

you must do everything to protect your children. Use the law, lawfully to secure their future.

1 Timothy 5:8

But if anyone does not provide for his own, and especially for those of his household, he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever.

focusing on doing what honors God

Proverbs 3:5-10

Trust in the LORD with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding; :6 In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths. :7 Do not be wise in your own eyes; Fear the LORD and depart from evil. :8 It will be health to your flesh, And strength to your bones. :9 Honor the LORD with your possessions, And with the firstfruits of all your increase; :10 So your barns will be filled with plenty, And your vats will overflow with new wine.

focusing on what's righteous and just

Isaiah 40:31

They that wait upon the LORD Shall renew *their* strength; They shall mount up with wings like eagles, They shall run and not be weary, They shall walk and not faint.

what would be the reason(s) for remarrying?

Fear of **being alone**. The fear of **missing out** on life. The fear of not being **taken care of**...

Everything that a dynamic, engaging, useful Christian life can provide you...

There are so many wonderful Christians who,

after they're divorced said... *"that's it Lord, it's just you and me now -- so let's get this party started"*

Ephesians 5:15-17

See then that you walk **circumspectly**, not as fools but as wise, **:16 redeeming** the time, because the days are evil. **:17** Therefore do not be unwise, but understand what **the will of the Lord is**.

3.) Strengthening – you will want to strengthen your life

a divorced Christian must fight harder...

against temptation as well as resist compromising situations.

Don't Go From the Fire - into the

Frying Pan

1 Corinthians 6:18-19

Flee sexual immorality. Every sin that a man does is outside the body, but he who commits sexual immorality sins against his own body. **:19** Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit *who is* in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own?

Your strength needs to be **anchored** in a **deep** and **committed** personal relationship with Jesus Christ.

2 Timothy 2:15

Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that need not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth. **:16** But **shun** profane and vain babblings: for they will increase unto more ungodliness.

Romans 10:17 So then faith *comes* by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

Make Every Effort to Build-Up Your "Ethos"

Jude 20-21

But you, dear friends, build yourselves up in your most holy faith and pray in the Holy Spirit. **21** Keep yourselves in God's love as you wait for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ to bring you to eternal life.

4.) Determining – you will make different decisions now

does the Lord even want you to marry again?

(it's not important what you want - it's about what He wants)

1 Corinthians 7:39

A wife is bound by law as long as her husband lives; but if her husband dies, she is at liberty to be married to whom she wishes, only in the Lord.

1 Corinthians 7:10-11

Now to the married I command, *yet* not I but the Lord: A wife is not to depart from *her* husband **:11** But even if she does depart, let her remain unmarried or be reconciled to *her* husband. **And a husband is not to divorce his wife.**

2 Corinthians 6:14-16

Do not be unequally yoked together with unbelievers. For what fellowship has righteousness with lawlessness? And what communion has light with darkness? **:15** And what accord has Christ with Belial? Or what part has a believer with an unbeliever? **:16** And what agreement has the temple of God with idols? For you are the temple of the living God.

Are you unhappy in your marriage? Are you separated? (unbiblical) Are you going thru a divorce?

Then stay away from where singles hang out – you're still married ! Then don't dress in a way to get looks – you're still married ! Then keep your ring on your finger – you're still married !

5.) Being – you will live a more dedicated life to God

Have Some Respect for You – The Lord Does...

Romans 12:1-2

I beseech (urge) you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, *which is* your reasonable service. **:2** And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may **prove what** *is* **that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.**

Ephesians 5:15-17

See then that you walk **circumspectly**, not as fools but as wise, **:16 redeeming** the time, because the days are evil. **:17** Therefore do not be unwise, but **understand** what **the will of the Lord is**.

1 Thessalonians 4:3-7

For this is the will of God, your sanctification: that you should abstain from sexual immorality; (sex outside of marriage) :4 that each of you should know how to possess his own vessel in sanctification and honor, :5 not in passion of lust, like the Gentiles (unbelievers) who do not know God; :6 that no one should take advantage of and defraud his brother (sister – fellow Christian) in this matter, because the Lord *is* the avenger of all such, as we also forewarned you and testified. :7 For God did not call us to uncleanness, but in holiness.

Hebrews 10:24-25

And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works, **:25** not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as *is* the manner of some, but exhorting *one another,* and so much the more as you see the Day approaching.

Isaiah 54:3-6

For you shall expand to the right and to the left, And your descendants will inherit the nations, And make the desolate cities inhabited. :4 "Do not fear, for you will not be ashamed; Neither be disgraced, for you will not be put to shame;
For you will forget the shame of your youth, And will not remember the reproach of your widowhood anymore. :5 For your Maker *is* your husband, The LORD of hosts *is* His name; And your Redeemer *is* the Holy One of Israel; He is called the God of the whole earth. :6 For the LORD has called you Like a woman forsaken and grieved in spirit, Like a youthful wife when you were refused," Says your God.
