John 1:29

"State The Contextual Summation and Theme"

!!! Merry Christmas !!!

If I had to pick one word that best describes Christmas to me, it would be the word **Hope**.

But Can Hope be Given as a Gift?

You bet it can. And it truly qualifies as a Gift. You **can't buy** hope for yourself. You **can't borrow** hope from somebody. Hope **can't be earned** like a wage. You **can't order** hope at the drive thru window. Hope Can Only Be Given as a Gift

John 1:29b

"Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world! Matt. 1:18-23

Now the birth of Jesus Christ was as follows: After His mother Mary was betrothed to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Spirit. **:19** Then Joseph her husband, being a just *man*, and not wanting to make her a public example, was minded to put her away secretly. **:20** But while he thought about these things, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take to you Mary your wife, for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Spirit. **:21** And she will bring forth a Son, and you shall call His name JESUS, for He will save His people from their sins." **:22** So all this was done that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the Lord through the prophet Isaiah, saying: **:23** "Behold, the virgin shall be with child, and bear a Son, and they shall call His name Immanuel," which is translated, "God with us."

So it was, that while Joseph and Mary were there, the days were completed for her to deliver. :7 And she brought forth her firstborn Son, and wrapped Him in swaddling cloths, and laid Him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn. :8 Now there were in the same country shepherds living out in the fields, keeping watch over their flock by night. :9 And behold, an angel of the Lord stood before them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were greatly afraid. :10 Then the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid, for behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy which will be to all people. :11 For there is born to you this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord. :12 And this will be the sign to you: You will find a Babe wrapped in swaddling cloths, lying in a manger." :13 And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God and saying: :14 "Glory to God in the highest, And on earth peace, goodwill toward men!"

After this, Joseph of Arimathea, being a disciple of Jesus, but secretly, for fear of the Jews, asked Pilate that he might take away the body of Jesus; and Pilate gave him permission. So he came and took the body of Jesus. :39 And Nicodemus, who at first came to Jesus by night, also came, bringing a mixture of myrrh and aloes, about a hundred pounds. :40 Then they took the body of Jesus, and bound it in strips of linen (large swaddling sheets) with the spices, as the custom of the Jews is to bury. :41 Now in the place where He was crucified there was a garden, and in the garden a new tomb (stone crib)
