1 Timothy 3:16

And without **controversy** great is the mystery of **godliness**: (1) God was **manifested** in the flesh, (2) Justified in the Spirit, (3) Seen by angels, (4) Preached among the Gentiles, (5) Believed on in the world, (6) Received up in glory.

Matt. 1:1-2,18-25 & Matt. 2:1-12

The book of the genealogy of Jesus Christ, the Son of David, the Son of Abraham :2 Abraham begot Isaac, Isaac begot Jacob, and Jacob...

:18 Now the birth of Jesus Christ was as follows: After His mother Mary was betrothed to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Spirit. 19 Then Joseph her husband, being a just man, and not wanting to make her a public example, was minded to put her away secretly. 20 But while he thought about these things, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take to you Mary your wife, for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Spirit. 21 And she will bring forth a Son, and you shall call His name JESUS, for He will save His people from their sins." :22 So all this was done that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the Lord through the prophet, saying: 23 "Behold, the virgin shall be with child, and bear a Son, and they shall call His name Immanuel," which is translated. "God with us." :24 Then Joseph, being aroused from sleep, did as the angel of the Lord commanded him and took to him his wife, 25 and did not know her till she had brought forth her firstborn Son. And he called His name JESUS. 2:1 Now after Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea in the days of Herod the king, behold, wise men from the East came to Jerusalem, 2 saying, "Where is He who has been born King of the Jews? For we have seen His star in the East and have come to worship Him." :3 When Herod the king heard this, he was troubled, and all Jerusalem with him. 4 And when he had gathered all the chief priests and scribes of the people together, he inquired of them where the Christ was to be born. :5 So they said to him, "In Bethlehem of Judea, for thus it is written by the prophet: 6 "But you, Bethlehem, in the land of Judah, Are not the least among the rulers of Judah; For out of you shall come a Ruler Who will shepherd My people Israel.' ":7 Then Herod, when he had secretly called the wise men, determined from them what time the star appeared. 8 And he sent them to Bethlehem and said, "Go and search carefully for the young Child, and when you have found Him, bring back word to me, that I may come and worship Him also." :9 When they heard the king, they departed; and behold, the star which they had seen in the East went before them, till it came and stood over where the young Child was. 10 When they saw the star, they rejoiced with exceedingly great joy. 11 And when they had come into the house, they saw the young Child with Mary His mother, and fell down and worshiped Him. And when they had opened their treasures, they presented gifts to Him: gold, frankincense, and myrrh. :12 Then, being divinely warned in a dream that they should not return to Herod, they departed for their own country another way.

CHRISTMAS BEING BORN OUT OF HEAVEN MEANS

1a.) Christmas never had a beginning

1 Timothy 3:16

And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness:

This is a Bold Declaration Here;

"Without controversy"

ὑμολογουμένως homologoumenos, *hom-ol-og-ow-men´-oce;* obviously, clearly, reasonably, without doubt. No contest or it's no controversy.

"Great is the mystery"

The "Megas Musterion" υστήριον musterion, moos-tay'-ree-on; from a something that has always been but not made known. The unveiling of an eternal truth into time and space.

"Of godliness" a visible, physical, tangible display of God-like-ness

The Argument for the Existence of God is Actually a Natural Assumption. Example: Genesis 1:1

Luke 2:6-11

So it was, that while they were there, the days were completed for her to be delivered. 7 And she brought forth her firstborn Son, and wrapped Him in swaddling cloths, and laid Him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn. (all common) :8 Now there were in the same country shepherds living out in the fields, keeping watch over their flock by night. 9 And behold, an angel of the Lord stood before them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were greatly afraid. 10 Then the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid, for behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy which will be to all people. 11 For there is born to you this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord.

1c.) Christmas is to be appreciated

1 Timothy 3:16

And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was (2) Justified in the Spirit

by "appreciated" I mean, "respected" in the sense of having to cope with or to deal with. Technically, to be decided upon. Christmas demands recognition by its very nature.

This "Justified" in or by the Spirit means... That everything about Jesus Christ is by the Power of the Holy Spirit. From His conception to His ministry, His death and resurrection – it was all done by and through the Person of the Holy Person.

This "Justification" was never more meaningful and powerful than when Jesus Christ was raised from the dead.

As Jesus walked in obedience to the will of the Father (in His humanity) the Holy Spirit was His Divine source of power.

By Jesus' righteousness in His flesh, He qualified mankind for salvation. By Jesus' justification in the Spirit, He secured for mankind forgiveness

1d.) Christmas shouts a miracle

And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was (3) Seen by angels,

THE FATHER'S "GIFT-GIVEN" WAS AT ALL COSTS !!!

"Seen by angels"

Luke 1:26-31

Now in the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent by God to a city of Galilee named Nazareth, 27 to a virgin betrothed to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David. The virgin's name was Mary. 28 And having come in, the angel said to her, "Rejoice, highly favored one, the Lord is with you; blessed are you among women!" :29 But when she saw him, she was troubled at his saying, and considered what manner of greeting this was. 30 Then the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. 31 And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bring forth a Son, and shall call His name JESUS.

Joseph – I need you to listen to me. I'm pregnant, but I'm still a virgin. Something has happened to me, to us – I need you to believe me.

Joseph also went up from Galilee, out of the city of Nazareth, into Judea, to the city of David, which is called Bethlehem, because he was of the house and lineage of David, 5 to be registered with Mary, his betrothed wife, who was with child.

Received up in glory

ἀναλαμβάνω analambano, an-al-am-ban´-o; to be taken up, to be received up, (in the sense of returning)

Acts 1:9-11

Now when He had spoken these things, while they watched, He was taken up, and a cloud received Him out of their sight. 10 And while they looked steadfastly toward heaven as He went up, behold, two men stood by them in white apparel, 11 who also said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand gazing up into heaven? This same Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will so come in like manner as you saw Him go into heaven."

I find it absolutely amazing that when God chose to come into the human race, He did so by placing Himself in the sanctuary of a woman.
