Witness GRK Martus (mar'-toos)

a literal witness in a judicial sense. one who records or recounts, "a martyr"

Tips from the Life of Stephen

- An Interesting Note;
 - 1.) Stephen was one of the Hellenists (*Greek speaking Jew*)
 - 2.) He was probably from this very synagogue (home)
 - 3.) He's a lot like us today (going back to those whom we love)
- The Name Stephen means; "The Victor's Crown"

And in the New Testament there are two words for crown:

- Diadema, "A Royal Crown by birth"
- Stephanos, "An Achievers Crown, Received or Earned"

• <u>Stephen in a Real a Way</u> is a "type of the believer." As the reward that Jesus will receive when the church is removed from the earth.

The Various Judgments found in the Bible

All of them are yet future. Some are in relationship to Gentile nations and how they treat Israel in the last days (Matthew 25). Another is that of those who die not receiving Jesus as Savior (Revelation 20:11)

Then there is The Judgment Seat of Christ

2 Corinthians 5:10

For we (the believers) must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may receive the things done in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad.

Seat GRK bema (bay'-ma) a step up, i.e. foot-span a platform

Stephen's Witness Comes as a natural outgrowth of church revival;

Acts 6:7

And the word of God spread, and the number of the disciples multiplied greatly in Jerusalem,

Verse 8

And Stephen, Full of Faith & Power

Faith	GRK	pistis (pis'-tis) a faith that's persuasive, assurance, Graceful.
Power	GRK	dunamis (doo'-nam-is); force, strength, tenacious mighty
Full	GRK	pleres (play'-race) covered up and over

To be full or to be filled,

assumes that we can be full or filled. before we can be filled we must assume that we are empty.

emptied of "self-life" and there are many books and authors that tell us that we must put down self, destroy self, beat self...

We need to simply lose self

Matthew 16:25

"For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake will find it.

lose GRK apollumi (ap-ol'-loo-mee) to turn lose, to mar, to let die.

"I" Tried to Empty Myself, but the "I" part got in the way

1 Peter 3:15

But sanctify (set apart) the Lord God in your hearts, and always be ready to give a **defense** to everyone who asks you, a reason for the hope that is in you, with meekness and respect;

defense GRK apologia (ap-ol-og-ee'-ah)

a plea, a cry, an issuance, testimony of proof. Apologetics

Knowing, therefore, the fear (awesome being) of the Lord, we persuade (influence or convince) men; -2

Corinthians 5:11

vv. 9-10

David Hume once was seen attending one of George Whitefield's Crusades and a man noticing him asked "why are you coming out to hear Whitefield, you don't even believe in what he preaches?" and David Hume said "that's right, I don't believe in what he preaches...but he does"

2 Timothy 1:12

...I am not ashamed, **for I know** whom I have believed <u>and am persuaded</u> that He is able to keep what I have committed to Him until that Day.

Know GRK eido (**i'-do**) to be keenly aware of, to have divine perception

Students Note This:

The "Freedmen" were Ex-slaves or Liberated Ones

The Organized Opposition once again comes from the "Representatives of Religion"

Not able to Contradict or ignore

The spirit by which he spoke was the Holy Spirit, who was <u>able</u> to speak through him not only upon Stephen, but filled up with

"Not Able to Resist the Wisdom"

a winsomeness or divine enthusiasm which rendered them powerless

James 3:17

the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality and without hypocrisy.

Luke 21:15

"for I will give you a mouth and wisdom which all your adversaries will not be able to contradict or resist.

2.)	Be Right	Before the World	vv. 9-10	

3.) Be Resting In the World vv. 11-14

Verse 11

• 1st "They <u>Secretly</u> induced"

Or bought men off

Verse 12

• 2nd "They Stirred up the people"

Like snakes from off the jungle floor.

Verse 13

• 3rd "They Set up false witnesses"

To the believer in Judaism, The Temple was the touchstone for the forgiveness of sins, for their relationship between man \mathcal{E} God. it was the icon of everything meaningful.

When We Witness (*live it out*) Those around us will be "pressured" to make a Decision... Yes or No, but pressured.

Verse 14

Stephen was guilty of stealing a sermon from Jesus !!!

- Jesus did say that the temple was going to be destroyed (i.e. **His body**).
- He did say that The Temple would be destroyed in **Matthew 24**
- At this point, they were less than nine years away from that fulfillment.

John 2:19-21

Jesus answered and said to them, "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up." :20 Then the Jews said, "It has taken forty-six years to build this temple, and will You raise it up in three days?" :21 But He was speaking of the temple of His body.

Jesus said that He would fulfill, not change the law, but complete it.... but they were not willing to believe it
