BEING READY TO SHARE THE LORD

THEME:

Acts 1:8

"But you shall receive **power** when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and "**you shall be witnesses to Me"** in **Jerusalem**, and in all **Judea** and **Samaria**, and to the **end of the earth**."

When Engineers Wanted to build a bridge across the Niagara River, their first problem hit them hard... they couldn't get a rope across it because it was too great a river. So they first attached a string to a kite and they flew the kite across. Then they tied a wire to the string and pulled that across, then a rope to that string, then a barge to the rope, and then a bridge to the barge... God builds His church with a lot a little strings...

Isaiah 28:10

For the Lord says, precept upon precept, line upon line, here a little, there a little."

In verse 26-28 Paul Unveils to us the responsibility of every Christian in the family of God and that is... • To be active and effective about sharing Jesus • and to give out the complete instruction of Bible doctrine • so that the church will grow as a living dynamic in the world...

The Latter Part of Verse 28 gives us the Purpose of Paul the Apostle and the Passion of the Pastor Paul ...

...to shepherd the church of God!

Paul is Completing His Missionary Journey

1.) Having a Clear Conscience toward all Men vv. 26

First off, There Are (3) Things That We Need To See in Verse 26

A. We Must Be Willing to Witness of God vv. 26a

Have you ever Wondered if God speaks to You?

- does God ever speak to me?
- how do I know if it is God speaking to me?

God will often speak to you with words of Encouragement, or Love, or Direction. But ever Christian will be able to identify the voice of God when #1 were thinking about doing something wrong. #2 When He calls us to tell someone about His son Jesus! - (the struggle begins)

There are 2 Big Hearing Problems that we Have...

(Having Sin on Our Hands)

Isaiah 59:1-2

Behold, the LORD'S hand is not shortened, that it cannot save; nor His ear heavy, that it cannot hear. :2 But your iniquities have separated you from your God; and your sins have hidden His face from you, so that He will not hear.

(Having Fat in Our Ears)

Hebrews 5:11

I'd like to talk to more about Jesus of whom we have much to say, but it will be **hard to explain**, **since you have (become) (dull) of hearing.**

"Hard to Explain"

The Meaning is that they had Experienced a Spiritual Peak in their walk and now were gradually descending down from where they had come.

"You Have "Become" (an acquired, degenerating trend) Sluggish of Ear"

"You Have Become Dull of Hearing"

* Dull 3576 nothros (no-thros');

to become sluggish, thick, to plug the ear with fat, apathetic, to lose passion, deadened.

Ceasing to contribute to

* Hearing 189 akoe (ak-o-ay')

to stop being an audience

Verse 26

 $Tells \ us \ the \ ''why'' \ {\it of our mission as Christians}. \ {\it It means that we are to be searching hi \& lo for anyone who needs to hear the message of Jesus Christ!}$

We will either be Evangelizing as a church or we will Fossilize as a people

Romans 3:23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

Romans 3:12

They have all turned aside; they have together become unprofitable; there is none who does good, no, not one."

We are to Reach them - with Jesus!

Luke 15:10

"Likewise, I say to you, there is joy in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents." - THE PRODIGAL SON

(the only story that portrayed God in a hurry - hurry to forgive)

"Therefore"

The "Therefore" is therefore a great reason and it is found in verse 25

Verse 25

"now I know that you all, among whom I have gone preaching the kingdom of God, - will see my face no more.

He's handing the Baton over to the Ephesian Pastors...

(I use to be Fast, very Fast, Running the 440 relay)

The Baton, right hand to left to right hand The Hand off was the critical moment

B. Because He Looked through 'Eternity' glasses vv. 26b

Why did Paul call the Ephesian elders together?

I <u>testify</u> to you <u>this day</u>

* Testify GRK 3143 marturomai (mar-too'-rom-ahee);

a legal, courtroom term meaning "I give testimony before these witnesses, (God being the Judge)

"this day"

Baton Passed! "This is the Apostle Paul Signing Off"

Paul's Preaching had an End!!!

2 Thessalonians 1:10

when Jesus comes, in **that Day**, to be glorified in His saints and to be admired among all those who believe, because our testimony among you was believed.

He Operated Under an Eternal time clock

daylight (soul) savings time

2 Timothy 1:12

I am not ashamed, for I know whom I have believed and am persuaded that He is able to keep what I have committed to Him until **that Day**.

2 Timothy 4:8

Finally, there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give to me on **that Day**, and not to me only but also to all who have loved His appearing.

C. By being Innocent of the Outcome vv. 26c

that I am innocent of the blood of all men.

* Innocent GRK 2513 katharos (kath-ar-os'); to have become clean, or cleared of a task, to have fulfilled a call

We Need to Ask a Question, What does it mean to be innocent of the blood of all men

How Do We as a Church be Innocent?

start seeing the church the way Jesus Sees it!

Matthew 28:18-19

And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. :19 "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,

Here In Verse 27, There Is (1) Thing

That We Need To Identify With.....

....If we are going to be Faithful to the Biblical Message

Verse 27

Gives us the "what" of our mission as Christians when we say the "the What" we mean the content of our preaching, teaching and our living out of the whole counsel of the Bible.

1 Corinthians 15:1-4

Moreover, brethren, I declare to you the gospel which I preached to you, which also you received and in which you stand, :2 by which also you are saved, if you hold fast that word which I preached to you-- unless you believed in vain. :3 For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, :4 and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures,

for the word of God never came by the will of man, but holy men of God spoke as they were moved by the Holy Spirit.

Nehemiah 8:5

And Ezra opened the book in the sight of all the people, for he was standing above all the people; and when he opened it, all the people stood up. :6 And Ezra blessed the LORD, the great God. Then all the people answered, "Amen, Amen!" while lifting up their hands. Verse 28

Teaches us "The Where" of our mission as Christians, when we say The Where, we mean the gathering of God's people, the church of Jesus Christ in the earth today.

A. Warning us to Take Heed to yourself First vv. 28a

Therefore take heed to YOURSELVES

* Heed GRK 4337 prosecho (pros-ekh'-o)

to hold the mind to. to pay attention to, be cautious about,

True Ministry is the overflow of what's happening in your life and mine

- The People cannot be first in my life
- My family cannot be first in my life
- This church cannot be first in my life

Jesus Must be First in My Life

the overflow of that relationship.... is called ministry !!!

Abraham was Blessed of God because he first was an Altar Builder before he was a Well digger

Genesis 12:7

Then the LORD appeared to Abram and said, "To your descendants I will give this land."

And there he built an altar to the LORD, who had appeared to him.

B. Warning Pastors to Take Heed for the Body vv. 28b

and (take heed) to all THE FLOCK, among which the Holy Spirit has made you <u>overseers</u>,

My Job Is to Instruct You and to Warn You (blow the Trumpet)

where the truth is, falsehood will not be far away

Matthew 24:4 Jesus Said

"Take heed...... that no one deceives you. (false doctrine)

1846 LANSFORD HASTINGS & DONNER PARTY

Luke 11:35 Jesus Said

take heed..... that the light which is in you is not darkness. (false, imitation)

Luke 21:8 Jesus Said

Take heed.....For many will come in My name, saying, `I am He,' and, `The time has drawn near.'

Therefore do not go after them.

Mark 13:33 Jesus Said

Take heed..... watch and pray;

C. Because The Lord has Ordained His Pastors vv. 28c

to shepherd the church of God
POINT THEM IN THE RIGHT DIRECTION

Genesis 13:3

And he went on his journey from the South as far as Bethel, to the place where his tent had been at the beginning, between Bethel and Ai, :4 to the place of the altar which he had made there at first. And there Abram called on the name of the LORD.

D. Because it was Bought at a Great Price

vv. 28d

which He purchased with His own blood.

if gold backs the value of the U.S. Dollar, then what that dollar can buy represents it's worth...

If God backs the value of His Sons Blood, then what that blood can buy represents our worth

1 Corinthians 6:20

For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's.

1 Corinthians 7:23

You were bought at a price; do not become slaves of men.

The Ginger Bread Man... The little girl made him, but he ran away, finding him captured in a storefront window... she bought him

"Little Ginger Bread Man, I made you and now I have bought you, Now You're doubly Mine"
