INTRODUCTION: To The Text

vv. 19-21

19 Therefore, my beloved brethren, let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath; **20** for the wrath of man does not produce the righteousness of God.

21 Therefore lay aside all filthiness and overflow of wickedness, and receive with meekness the implanted word, which is able to save your souls.

The Summation Sentence

Verses 19-27
are made of three divisions

“Receiving the Word of Truth”

vv. 19-21

“Practicing the Word of Truth”

vv. 22-25

“Sharing the Word of Truth”

vv. 26-27

In these three divisions, James sets forth before the believer a series of tests, examinations really, that confirms or denies the fact that we are truly believers who have become followers

Jesus Warned Against Spectator Christianity

Luke 6:44

"For every tree is known by its own fruit. For men do not gather figs from thorns, nor do they gather grapes from a bramble bush.

Jude Warned Against Spectator Christianity

Jude 1:12

These are spots in your love feasts, while they feast with you without fear, serving only themselves. They are clouds without water, carried about by the winds; late autumn trees without fruit, twice dead, pulled up by the roots;

By the way,
*do you know what you call believers
who have become followers of Christ?
- Christians!*

You can be a believer in God and
you can say that you follow Christ...
but until you take your belief and put it into action,
in day-to-day living, - you'll never be a Christian

The fact of the matter is
you'll wind up missing heaven by about 18 inches
(the distance between your head and your heart)

Religion among men is of the head - Relationship with God is in the heart.
One talks about it - The other does it

James 1:22

swift to hear grk 5036 tachus (takh-oos');
positioned and eager to receive. To turn the head as to hear better,
to understand more.

Like a mother to her babies cry
It's a discernible way of hearing

Mark 4:24

"Consider carefully what you hear,"

This is so important
that God made us with 2 ears and just 1 mouth

We are to listen twice as much as we speak

c.) By Making Us Like Christ

vv. 19c

slow to speak, slow to wrath;

This is so much like the nature of Jesus Christ

When you look at the Word - You're Looking at Jesus

1 Corinthians 13:4-8

4 Love **(Jesus)** suffers long and is kind; love **(Jesus)** does not envy; love **(Jesus)** does not parade itself, **(Jesus)** is not puffed up; 5 does not behave rudely, **(Jesus)** does not seek its own, is not provoked, **(Jesus)** thinks no evil; 6 does not rejoice in iniquity, but **(Jesus)** rejoices in the truth; 7 **(Jesus)** bears all things, **(Jesus)** believes all things, **(Jesus)** hopes all things, endures all things. 8 Love**(Jesus)** never fails.

Romans 8:29

For whom He foreknew, He also predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn

It's hard to

when your mouth is always moving

- the words we use
- how we use them
- what we desire to accomplish with the words we use

does not produce the righteousness of God.

The Word of God Directs Our New Life

a.) By Showing us a More Excellent Way to Live

vv. 20a

for the **wrath** of man

If a man is slow to hear and swift to speak,
he will naturally be swift to wrath

* **wrath** grk 3709 orge (or-gay');
a seething human anger, human indignation, a burning human
vengeance.

A slow, seething anger
that schemes and plans vengeance

“I don't care if it takes me the rest of my life - I'll get him
- if it's the last thing I do”

It is of Demonic Origins - The Fallen Human Nature

Matthew 16:23

But He turned and said to Peter, "Get behind Me, Satan! You are an offense to Me, for you are not
mindful of the things of God, but the things of men."

A “Subcutaneous” Wrath
which will deceive you

At the end of the age
God will take man's actions, the governments, each individual, our judges

Psalm 76:10

Surely your wrath against men brings you praise,

Genesis 18:25

Shall not the Judge of all the earth do right?" (righteously)

In His wrath - there's love

God's Love is Rarely Understood

Perfect Love Instructs, it Directs, it Guides, it Provides,
it disciplines, it rebukes, it corrects, it judges

The Word of God Directs Our New Life

b.) By Displaying to Us the Proper Motivation

vv. 20b

does not **produce** the **righteousness** of God.

Man's Wrath cannot produce Righteousness
It cannot, has no ability or power to, is incapable

The Pulpit Pounder, Sin Sniffer, Fault Finder

the broken sinner or the self-righteous Pharisee?

Luke 15:1-2

1 Then drew near unto him all the publicans and sinners for to hear him. 2 And the Pharisees and scribes murmured, saying, This man receiveth sinners, and eateth with them.

Therefore lay aside

That sounds so nice and sweet doesn't it ?

* filthiness grk: dirty, gross filth, wax in the ear. that which is void of morality

Having wax in the ear Lay aside the wax that's in your ear

Unable to hear so as to correct your course because of the wax in the ear

Hebrews 5:11

it's hard to explain things to you, since you have become dull (fat in your ears) of hearing.

Matthew 13:15-16

15 For the hearts of this people have grown dull. Their ears are hard of hearing, and their eyes they have closed, lest they should see with their eyes and hear with their ears, lest they should understand with their hearts and turn, so that I should heal them.' 16 "But blessed are your eyes for they see, and your ears for they hear;

* overflow grk 4052 perisseuo (per-is-syoo'-o);
to super amount, to the point of excessiveness. More than what's expected

James 1:21

get rid of all moral filth and the evil that is so prevalent.

(NIV)

The thought is:

**A tank that is overfilled and spewing forth out
of an opening**

Resist It / Pray against / Vote against

Hebrews 12:2-4

2 looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. 3 For consider Him who endured such hostility from sinners against Himself, lest you become weary and discouraged in your souls. 4 You have not yet resisted to bloodshed, striving against sin.

IS INTERNALIZING THE BIBLE

* **implanted** grk 1721 emphutos (em'-foo-tos);
from 1722 and a derivative of 5453; implanted (figuratively): to be grafted in to --
causing germination after it has been grafted in to what once was foreign

Engrafted

Being grafted in to the word, we become one with the word, then the word
reproduces in us its truth, which springs forth into right living

The Seed, The Word

Matthew 13:1-9

1 On the same day Jesus went out of the house and sat by the sea. 2 And great multitudes were gathered together to Him, so that He got into a boat and sat; and the whole multitude stood on the shore. 3 Then He spoke many things to them in parables, saying: "Behold, a sower went out to sow. 4 "And as he sowed, some seed fell by the wayside; and the birds came and devoured them. 5 "Some fell on stony places, where they did not have much earth; and they immediately sprang up because they had no depth of earth. 6 "But when the sun was up they were scorched, and because they had no root they withered away. 7 "And some fell among thorns, and the thorns sprang up and choked them. 8 "But others fell on good ground and yielded a crop: some a hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty. 9 "He who has ears to hear, let him hear!"

Jesus Compares the Word to Seed

the seed germinates - the Seed has power - the seeds will grow

Matthew 13:18-23

18 "Therefore hear the parable of the sower: 19 "When anyone hears the word of the kingdom, and does not understand it, then the wicked one comes and snatches away what was sown in his heart. This is he who **received** seed by the wayside. 20 "But he who **received** the seed on stony places, this is he who hears the word and immediately receives it with joy; 21 "yet he has no root in himself, but endures only for a while. For when tribulation or persecution arises because of the word, immediately he stumbles. 22 "Now he who **received** seed among the thorns is he who hears the word, and the cares of this world and the deceitfulness of riches choke the word, and he becomes unfruitful. 23 "But he who **received** seed on the good ground is **he who hears the word and understands it, who indeed bears fruit and produces: some a hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty."**

Go out to your driveway at home

You'll find a sprout breaking through the concrete

Silently / slowly - - but noticeably

The True Evidence of Salvation is fruit

Consider the Fruit that has come from the ministry of the Thief on the Cross.
Saved for a couple of hours at best - the untold millions who have had death bed conversions

A Changed Life

Manifested by various and noticeable characteristics of the new life

which leads to winning souls

Romans 1:16

For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes,

which leads to holy living

Romans 6:22

But now having been set free from sin, and having become slaves of God, you have your fruit to holiness, and the end, everlasting life.

which leads to sharing possessions

Romans 15:28

Therefore, when I have performed this and have sealed to them this fruit, I shall go by way of you to Spain.

which leads to deeper knowledge

Galatians 5:22-23

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law.

which leads to good works

Colossians 1:10

that you may have a walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God;

which leads to a worshipful life

Hebrews 13:15

Therefore by Him let us continually offer the sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of our lips, giving thanks to His name.

dynamite. to make possible: having the power to change or do.

**First, in verse 18, the word came to our ears
through evangelism.**

**Then, the word began to take root and grow in
verse 21a.**

**And now, the word of God is at work in us,
bringing us to the completed work of our
redemption**

**“Your souls”
the ALL of who you really are**

**Have you ever been knocked out,
put under, or dreamed a dream?**

Your body and your mind are in two different places at the same time
