that there is something to be gained or a reward to be had by completing the Mission in Question

 - Does the Mission Success provide any Valuable Rewards?

Jesus Gave an Example

Luke 14:28-31

"For which of you, intending to build a tower, does not sit down first and count the cost, whether he has enough to finish it-- 29 "lest, after he has laid the foundation, and is not able to finish, all who see it begin to mock him, 30 "saying, 'This man began to build and was not able to finish.' 31 "Or what king, going to make war against another king, does not sit down first and consider whether he is able with ten thousand to meet him who comes against him with twenty thousand?

In The Middle of the Atlantic Ocean, - In a Series of Clandestine Meetings

Between President FDR and Winston Churchill The Involvement of the United States of America was requested with hopes to Liberate Europe from Germany.

As The President Considered The Cost...

Roosevelt asked - - "And what's in it for America" Churchill's response was simple, "A Free Europe and a Free World"

A Mission Must Be Defined

Christ and His Mission

1.) The **Purpose** of His Mission

an Invitation to Consider the Biblical Record

The "Purpose" of His Mission is Both Observable and Needed

a.) His Purpose was to Fulfill all that was Written

Luke 7:20-22

When the men had come to Him, they said, "John the Baptist has sent us to You, saying, 'Are You the Coming One, or do we look for another?'" 21 And that very hour He cured many of infirmities, afflictions, and evil spirits; and to many blind He gave sight. 22 Then Jesus answered and said to them, "Go and tell John the things you have seen and heard: that the blind see, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, the poor have the gospel preached to them.

Luke 24:25-27

Then He said to them, "O foolish ones, and slow of heart to believe in all that the prophets have spoken!26 "Ought not the Christ to have suffered these things and to enter into His glory?" 27 And beginning at Moses and all the Prophets, He expounded to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning Himself......

31 Then their eyes were opened and they knew Him; and He vanished from their sight. 32 And they said to one another, "Did not our heart burn within us while He talked with us on the road, and while He opened the Scriptures to us?"

Jesus Honored The Bible - Submitting to the Bible

b.) His Purpose was to Ransom Israel

Matthew 15:22-25

And behold, a woman of Canaan came from that region and cried out to Him, saying, "Have mercy on me, O Lord, Son of David! My daughter is severely demonpossessed." 23 But He answered her not a word. And His disciples came and urged Him, saying, "Send her away, for she cries out after us." 24But He answered and said, "I was not sent except to the lost sheep of the house of Israel." 25Then she came and worshiped Him, saying, "Lord, help me!"

c.) His Purpose was to Liberate the Gentile Nations

Personally,

I am 25% Irish, 25% German, and 50% Portuguese (i am as gentile as i can be – yet He has invited me to be His child)

Isaiah 11:10

"And in that day there shall be a Root of Jesse, who shall stand as a banner to the people; for the Gentiles shall seek Him...

"at the Joppa Stand"

Peter's Joppa Revelation

Acts 11:18

When they heard these things they became silent; and they glorified God, saying, "Then God has also granted to the Gentiles repentance to life."

Matthew 13:44

"Again, the kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field, which **a man** (the Lord) found and hid; and for joy over it he goes and sells all that he has and buys that field.

Matthew 13:45-46

"Again, the kingdom of heaven is like **a merchant** (the Lord) seeking beautiful pearls, 46 who, when he had found one pearl of great price, went and sold all that he had and bought it.

2.) The Scope of His Mission

Scope! "The Far Reaching Hand of God"

Matthew 9:36

But when He saw the multitudes, He was moved with **compassion** for them, because they were weary and scattered, like sheep having no shepherd.



Compassion grk4697 splagchnizomai (splangkh-nid'-zom-ahee); to have the bowels ache, yearn, break with passion

- a.) The Scope of His Mission provided Temporal Liberation

 The Gospel Brings Peace to the Souls of Men
- b.) The Scope of His Mission was to provide Physical Relief

The Kingdom of God is a Kingdom of Temporal Ministry,

....Bestowing Mercy & Showing Grace

Mark 2:2-12

2 Immediately many gathered together, so that there was no longer room to receive them, not even near the door. And He preached the word to them. 3 Then they came to Him, bringing a paralytic who was carried by four men. 4 And when they could not come near Him because of the crowd, they uncovered the roof where He was. So when they had broken through, they let down the bed on which the paralytic was lying. 5 When Jesus saw their faith, He said to the paralytic, "Son, your sins are forgiven you." 6 And some of the scribes were sitting there and reasoning in their hearts, 7 "Why does this Man speak blasphemies like this? Who can forgive sins but God alone?" 8 But immediately, when Jesus perceived in His spirit that they reasoned thus within themselves, He said to them, "Why do you reason about these things in your hearts? 9 "Which is easier, to say to the paralytic, 'Your sins are forgiven you,' or to say, 'Arise, take up your bed and walk'? 10 "But that you may know that the Son of Man has power on earth to forgive sins"-- He said to the paralytic, 11 "I say to you, arise, take up your bed, and go your way to your house 12 Immediately he arose, took up the bed, and went out in the presence of them all, so that all were amazed and glorified God, saying, "We never saw anything like this!"

Even Creation is Waiting for Us to get with it...

Romans 8:19-20

For the earnest expectation of the creation eagerly waits for the revealing of the sons of God. 20 For the creation was subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of Him who subjected it

c.) The Scope of His Mission was to Provide Eternal Freedom

John 3:14-15

14 "And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of Man be lifted up, 15 "that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life.

This Eternal Life is Called "Salvation"

Acts 4:12

"Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved."

1 John 5:20

And we know that the Son of God has come and has given us an understanding, that we may know Him who is true; and we are in Him who is true, in His Son Jesus Christ.

This is the true God and eternal life.

John 1:12-13

But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name:

Do You Have Jesus Christ This Morning ?

3.) The Execution of His Mission

We See Jesus Determined

Luke 9:51

As the time approached for him to be taken up to heaven, Jesus resolutely set out for Jerusalem.

a.) Jesus Performed all that was Necessary

Matthew 5:17-18

"Do not think that I came to destroy the Law or the Prophets. I did not come to destroy but to fulfill. 18 "For assuredly, I say to you, till heaven and earth pass away, one jot or one tittle will by no means pass from the law till all is fulfilled.

Hebrews 12:1-2

Therefore we also, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, 2 looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

2 Corinthians 5:19

that is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their

b.) Jesus Directed all that was Important

Matthew 28:18-20

And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. 19 "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 "teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

c.) Jesus Imparted all that was Needed

John 16:5-11

"But now I go away to Him who sent Me, and none of you asks Me, 'Where are You going?' 6 "But because I have said these things to you, sorrow has filled your heart. 7 "Nevertheless I tell you the truth. It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you. 8 "And when He has come, He will convict the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: 9 "of sin, because they do not believe in Me; 10 "of righteousness, because I go to My Father and you see Me no more; 11 "of judgment, because the ruler of this world is judged.

Acts 1:4-5

And being assembled together with them, He commanded them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the Promise of the Father, "which," He said, "you have heard from Me; 5 "for John truly baptized with water, but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now."
