1.) Requires that you **Examine** Jesus Christ

vv. 35-37

Again, the next day, John stood with two of his disciples. **36** And looking at Jesus as He walked, he said, "Behold the Lamb of God!" **37** The two disciples heard him speak, and they followed Jesus.

v.35-36

Again, the next day, John **stood** with two of his disciples. 36 And **looking** at Jesus as He walked, he said, "Behold the Lamb of God!"

This Was Now The Second Time in Two Days That John Had Announced This Glorious Fact

John 1:29

(being jewish that took their mind back to a bloody night in egypt)

The Passover Lamb

And so They Stood and They Looked

This Time John Says Watch the Lamb Walk looking at Jesus as He walked

c.) Examination Results in Expectations

v. 37c

and they followed Jesus

THEY HAD MADE UP THEIR MINDS – A DECISION WAS MADE

Followed grk 190 akoloutheo (ak-loo-theia'-o);

To get on this road. To be on the same highway or to be in the same company of travelers. To follow the path of Another, reaching toward the One who's being Followed!

Have You Noticed That When You're Following Jesus He'll Take You to Places to Meet People

Luke 18:29-30

"Assuredly, I say to you, there is no one who has left house or parents or brothers or wife or children, for the sake of the kingdom of God, 30 "who shall not receive many times more in this present time, and in the age to come everlasting life."

2.) Asks of You to **Delight** in Jesus Christ

vv. 38-39

38 Then Jesus turned, and seeing them following, said to them, "What do you seek?" They said to Him, "Rabbi" (which is to say, when translated, Teacher), "where are You staying?" 39 He said to them, "Come and see." They came and saw where He wa staying, and remained with Him that day (now it was about the tenth hour).

a.) You're Hope will be Recognized

v.38

Then Jesus turned, and seeing them following, said to them, "What do you seek?

"Now Get Use To This Evangelistic Tactic of Jesus"

- Not a "Nice that You Could Follow"
 - Not a "Welcome Aboard Boys"
 - Not Even a

"What Would You Like to Have in a Church"

Not Even "Who" do you seek"

But - "WHAT"

Two Questions are Asked *One By Jesus - - One by these Men*

Verse 38

"What do you seek?" They said to Him, "Rabbi" (which is to say, when translated, Teacher), "where are You staying

The Answer to Both Questions is the Same... Come and See – I'll Show You!

Jesus is Examining Their Thoughts Now

He's Preparing Them for an Upcoming Conversation

see "What do you seek?

There are people who try Jesus for a while to see what they can get out of Him Maybe It's a Political Office / Maybe It's Earthly Power or Position

Verse 39

And They came and saw where He was staying, and remained with Him that day (now it was about the tenth hour roman time / 4 pm Jewish time).

We Know Little About Verses 38 & 39 BUT VOLUMES HAD TO BE REVEALED IN THEIR SILENCE

I Want to Know What Happened in the Silence Of Verse 39

What Ever Did Happen, It Led to Verses 40-41

(now that's profound expositional teaching at it's best - free of change at that)

3.) Compels You Toward Those You Love

vs. 40-42

40 One of the two who heard John speak, and followed Him, was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother. 41 He first found his own brother Simon, and said to him, **"We have found the Messiah"** (which is translated, the Christ). 42 And he brought him to Jesus. Now when Jesus looked at him, He said, "You are Simon the son of Jonah. You shall be called Cephas" (which is translated, A Stone).

b.) You're Sight will be Changed

v. 40-41

40 One of the two who heard John speak, and followed Him, was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother. 41 He first found his own brother Simon, and said to him, "We have found the Messiah" (which is translated, the Christ).

1 Timothy 4:11-16

These things command and teach. 12 Let no one despise your youth, but be an example to the believers in word, in conduct, in love, in spirit, in faith, in purity. 13 Till I come, give attention to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine. 14 Do not neglect the gift that is in you, which was given to you by prophecy with the laying on of the hands of the eldership. 15 Meditate on these things; give yourself entirely to them, that your progress may be evident to all. 16 Take heed to yourself and to the doctrine. Continue in them, for in doing this you will save both yourself and those who hear you.

4.) He Communicates to You Truth

vv. 43-46

43 The following day Jesus wanted to go to Galilee, and He found Philip and said to him, "Follow Me." 44 Now Philip was from Bethsaida, the city of Andrew and Peter. 45 Philip found Nathanael and said to him, "We have found Him of whom Moses in the law, and also the prophets, wrote-- Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph." 46 And Nathanael said to him, "Can anything good come out of Nazareth?" Philip said to him, "Come and see."

a.) That You're Personally Valuable to Him v 43-44

The following day Jesus wanted to go to Galilee, and He found Philip and said to him, "Follow Me." ." 44 Now Philip was from Bethsaida, the city of Andrew and Peter.

Two Things are Being Said Here at Once

Follow Me1205 deute (dyoo'-teh); USED ONCE HERE ONLY Grk imperative form to "go or leave the spot you're at and "Come to Me" – Come hither!

If My Child is Standing There Perched Upon a Stone Wall
And I Say to Her "Follow Me!" - (dyoo'-teh);
Leave at Once Your Place of Dwelling And Jump into My Arms!

The Two Things Being Said at Once is "Come"

For You Cannot Come Unless You Leave and You Cannot Follow Unless You Go!

Matthew 8:19-20

Then a certain scribe came and said to Him, "Teacher, I will follow You wherever You go."
