PART 1

1.) Requires that you **Examine** Jesus Christ

vv. 35-37

a.) Examine What it is about Him

vv. 35-36

...John **stood** with two of his disciples. 36 And **looking** at Jesus as He walked, he said, "Behold the Lamb of God!"

b.) Examination Should Lead you to Action

v. 37

Those two disciples who had **heard** john speak, they **followed** Jesus.

c.) Examination Results in Expectations

v. 37

they followed Jesus.

Followed grk 190 akoloutheo (ak-loo-theia'-o);
To get on THE road

Matthew 7:13-14

"Enter by the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it. 14 "Because narrow is the gate and difficult is the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it.

ALL ROADS LEAD TO GOD

(all of humanity must appear before God in the final day of judgement)

BUT ONLY ONE ROAD LEADS TO HEAVEN

(no man comes to the father but through Me says Jesus!)

2.) He Asks of You to **Delight** in Christ

vv. 38-39

a.) Your Hope will be Recognized

v. 38

Then Jesus turned, and seeing them following, said to them, "What do you seek?

b.) Your Sight will be Changed

v. 39

"What do you seek?" They said to Him, "Rabbi" (which is to say, when translated, Teacher), "where are You staying

c.) Your Joy will become a Reality

v. 39

And they came and saw where He was staying, and remained with Him that day (now it was about the tenth hour roman time / 4 pm Jewish time).

3.) Compels You toward those you love

vv. 40-42

a.) Your **Salvation** is based upon facts

vv. 40-41

40 One of the two who heard John speak, and followed Him, was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother. 41 He first found his own brother Simon, and said to him, "We have found the Messiah"

b.) Your Conversion will be Persuasive

v.42

42 And he brought him to Jesus. Now when Jesus looked at him, He said, "You are Simon the son of Jonah. You shall be called Cephas" (which is translated, A Stone).

4.) Jesus Will Communicate to you the Truth

vv. 43-46

a.) You're **Personally** Valuable to God

vv. 43-44

43 The following day Jesus wanted to go to Galilee, and He found Philip and said to him, "Follow Me." 44 Now Philip was from Bethsaida, the city of Andrew and Peter.

Philip, John and Nathanael. John is in the Middle!

b.) You're to **Depend** Upon His Word

v. 45

45 Philip found Nathanael and said to him, "We have found Him of whom Moses in the law, and also the prophets, wrote—Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph."

c.) You Shall Never be put to Shame

v. 46

46 And Nathanael said to him, "Can anything good come out of Nazareth?"

Philip said to him, "Come and see."

"Come and see Nathanael!"

Becoming a Follower of Jesus Christ Part II

This Portion of John Actually Dedicated to a Dialogue, Yes Between Jesus and Nathanael But Also Between Nathanael and His Bible

Our Dialogue With God Today is Better

John 16:13-14

"However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come. 14 "He will glorify Me, for He will take of what is Mine and declare it to you.

He Does This By His Indwelling of Us

Ezekiel 36:27

"I will put My Spirit within you

vv. 47-48

47 Jesus saw Nathanael coming toward Him, and said of him, "Behold, an Israelite indeed, in whom is no deceit!" 48
Nathanael said to Him, "How do You know me?" Jesus answered and said to him, "Before Philip called you, when you were under the fig tree, I saw you."

a.) The Lord Knows Who We Are

v.47

Jesus saw Nathanael coming toward Him, and said of him, "Behold, an Israelite...
"Behold", an Israelite!

He Speaks Having "More" Than First-Hand Knowledge

Nathanael, Whose Name Means "Gift of God"

God Knows All That Can Be Known About You

Psalm 139:14
I will praise You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made;
marvelous are Your works, and that my soul knows very well.

The Lord Knows Us

b.) The Lord Knows What We Are

v.47

"Behold, an Israelite indeed, in whom is no (guile) deceit!"

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Jeremiah 17:9
"The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked; who can know it?

A Crafty, Manipulative Lifestyle is Not Present in Nathanael

Ephesians 2:1-4

And you He made alive, who were dead in trespasses and sins, 2 in which you once walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit who now works in the sons of disobedience, 3 among whom also we all once conducted ourselves in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, just as the others. 4 But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us,

Nathanael Still Needed to be Born Again

c.) The Lord Knows Where We Are

v.48

Nathanael said to Him, "How do You know me?" Jesus answered and said to him, "Before Philip called you, when you were under the fig tree, I saw you."

Get Into Nate's Sandals Here

Before.... when you were under the fig tree

in the Hebrew construction of this sentence what is implied is that ((it was **Nathanael's Own Private or Favorite Fig Tree**))

I saw you.

The Omniscience of Jesus Christ is Seen Here His all Knowingness

I see you - ALWAYS !

Psalm 139:6-10

Such knowledge is too wonderful for me; it is high, I cannot attain unto it. 7 Whither shall I go from thy spirit? or whither shall I flee from thy presence? 8 If I ascend up into

heaven, thou art there: if I make my bed in hell, behold, thou art there. 9 If I take the wings of the morning, and dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea; 10 Even there shall thy hand lead me, and thy right hand shall hold me.

Own Private Fig Tree

One That He Had Selected for a Private Place

This speaks of private devotion Personal Devotion

In Manners and Customs of the Bible Dwelling, Reclining, Meditating under a Tree or on a Mountain Top was a Jew's Favorite form of Devotion

An Easy Assumption Can Be Made Here

Nathanael Must Have Been Thinking About the Glories of the Messiah's Kingdom to Come

Zechariah 3:10

"'In that day each of you will invite his neighbor to sit under his vine and fig tree,' declares the LORD Almighty."

Micah 4:4

But everyone shall sit under his vine and under his fig tree, and no one shall make them afraid; for the mouth of the LORD of hosts has spoken.

Without Personal Devotion

Because There are Decisions to be Made Because There are Actions to be Taken

"If God Would Reveal Himself to Jacob, Perhaps He Would Reveal Himself to Me Too"

Nathanael

By The Time I Got Done Working With Jacob I Had to Change His Name to **Israel**.

"From **Jacob** the Sneaky to **Israel** Ruled By God"

Ezekiel 18:31-32

"Cast away from you all the transgressions which you have committed, and get yourselves a new heart and a new spirit. For why should you die, O Israel. 32 "For I have no pleasure in the death of one who dies," says the Lord GOD. "Therefore turn and live!"

2.) Prepares Us to see God's Work

vv. 49-50

49 Nathanael answered and said to Him, "Rabbi, You are the Son of God! You are the King of Israel!" 50 Jesus answered and said to him, "Because I said to you, 'I saw you under the fig tree,' do you believe? You will see greater things than these."

a.) The Follower of Christ Looks to The Son of God v.49

Nathanael answered and said to Him, "Rabbi, You are the Son of God!

...THIS DIVINE KNOWLEDGE IMPRESSED HIM AT ONCE...

(as if a good thing can come out of Nazareth)

Jesus who is divinely privy to the personal information and whereabouts of Nathanael is preparing him for the revelation of Himself as Messiah.

Those the Lord Calls - He Prepares in Advance

Jeremiah 1:5

"Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, before you were born I set you apart; I appointed you as a prophet to the nations."

Becoming a Follower of Jesus Christ

b.) The Follower of Christ Acknowledges His Crown v.49

You are the King of Israel!"

This is the Long-Awaited Cry That God Listens for from the Nation Israel

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King grk 935 basileus (bas-il-yooce');
the sovereign (abstractly, relatively, or
figuratively)

Daniel 9:26 "...Messiah (The King) shall be cut off, but not for Himself;

A Christian is Someone who Lives Within a Kingdom Who is Subject to The King of that Kingdom Or Else They're Not of the Kingdom nor do they have a King

c.) The Follower of Christ can **Anticipate** more !!! v.50

Jesus answered and said to him, "Because I said to you, 'I saw you under the fig tree,' do you believe?

You will see greater things than these."

"You will see greater things than these."

More! More! More!

"Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father.

3.) **Determine** to Seek the Lord

vv. 51

51 And He said to him, "Most assuredly, I say to you, hereafter you shall see heaven open, and the angels of God ascending and descending upon the Son of Man."

The Mystery is Solved!

Genesis 28:10-17

Now Jacob went out from Beersheba and went toward Haran. 11 So he came to a certain place and stayed there all night, because the sun had set. And he took one of the stones of that place and put it at his head, and he lay down in that place to sleep. 12 Then he dreamed, and behold, a ladder was set up on the earth, and its top reached to heaven; and there the angels of God were ascending and descending on it. 13 And behold, the LORD stood above it and said: "I am the LORD God of Abraham your father and the God of Isaac; the land on which you lie I will give to you and your descendants. 14 "Also your descendants shall be as the dust of the earth; you shall spread abroad to the west and the east, to the north and the south; and in you and in your seed all the families of the earth shall be blessed. 15 "Behold, I am with you and will keep you wherever you go, and I will bring you back to this land; for I will not leave you until I have done what I have spoken to you." 16 Then Jacob awoke from his sleep and said, "Surely the LORD is in this place, and I did not know it." 17 And he was in awe and said, "How awesome is this place! I say to you, hereafter you shall see heaven open, and the angels of God ascending and descending upon the Son of Man."

No more Ladders Nathanael

Jacob Saw a Ladder With Angels Traveling Up and Down from Heaven to Earth

- I am Not Only That Ladder
- I am The One Whom the Angels Work For
- I am the Reason for Their Traveling in the First Place
