1.) The (way) God can use just one person vv. 27-30

John 4:27-30

27 And at this point His disciples came, and they marveled that He talked with a woman; yet no one said, "What do You seek?" or, "Why are You talking with her?" 28 The woman then left her waterpot, went her way into the city, and said to the men, 29 "Come, see a Man who told me all things that I ever did. Could this be the Christ?" 30 Then they went out of the city and came to Him.

a.) The disciples began to see with understanding v.27

27 And at this point His disciples came, and they marveled that He talked with a woman; yet no one said, "What do You seek?" or, "Why are You talking with her?"

The way God can use just one person

In the Life of Others - Disciples!!!

They began to understand That it was Jesus Here

The Rabbis taught that
Women were not worthy of conversation

***But the Disciples

v.28

28 The woman then **left** her waterpot,
went her way into the city, **and said to the men,**

THE men
(all six of them)

John 4:16-18

Jesus said to her, "Go, call your husband, and come here." 17 The woman answered and said, "I have no husband." Jesus said to her, "You have well said, 'I have no husband,' 18 "for you have had five husbands, and the one whom you now have is not your husband..

is Becoming urgent about the right***

Acts 4:13

Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were uneducated and untrained men, they marveled. And they realized that they had been with Jesus.

She Came Thirsty

- *But She Never Got a Drink*
then left **her waterpot**

Matthew 4:18-22

And Jesus, walking by the Sea of Galilee, saw two brothers, Simon called Peter, and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea; for they were fishermen. 19 Then He said to them, "Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men." 20 They **immediately left their nets** and followed Him. 21 Going on from there, He saw two other brothers, James the son of Zebedee, and John his brother, in the boat with Zebedee their father, mending their nets. And He called them, 22 and **immediately they left the boat** and their father, and followed Him.

The Lack of Urgency is a Grave Sign

Luke 14:16-20

Then He said to him, "A certain man gave a great supper and invited many, 17 "and sent his servant at supper time to say to those who were invited, 'Come, for all things are now ready.' 18 "But they all with one accord began to make excuses. The first said to him, 'I have bought a piece of ground, and I must go and see it. I ask you to have me excused.' 19 "And another said, 'I have bought five yoke of oxen, and I am going to test them. I ask you to have me excused.' 20 "Still another said, 'I have married a wife, and therefore I cannot come.'

The way God can use just one person

c.) *The men began to see with expectancy*

v.29-30

29 "Come, see a Man who told me all things that I ever did. Could this be the Christ?" 30 Then **they** went out of the city and came to Him.

To Them – Her Verbal Testimony Meant Little, it was what they saw in her – LIFE. A REASON, A PURPOSE

1.) She Had Approached Them (the 6)

2.) They begin to entertain the possibility

3.) The level of interest is enough for them to get going

Becoming urgent about the right

When we begin to see

with understanding

that Jesus is out to save souls, every soul

and with boldness

knowing that the message that we have
to give stands alone

and with expectancy

because people die daily and hell is real so the
invitation goes daily to all who are in the world

2.) The (will) that God has for each of us

vv. 31-38

John 4:31-38

31. the **"Will"** is God's Desire for us

God's will is that we take
as many people with us as is possible

2 Peter 3:9

...not willing that any should perish but that
all should come to repentance.

We must go to the world / We must tell the world
But we must start with our Jerusalem (home)
see to it that our children know that way first

c.) *Every one of us has our calling in ministry v.36-38*

"And he who reaps receives wages, and gathers fruit for eternal life, that both he who sows and he who reaps may rejoice together. 37 "For in this the saying is true: 'One sows and another reaps.' 38 "I sent you to reap that for which you have not labored; others have labored, and you have entered into their labors."

WE SHALL REAP

Psalm 126:5-6

Those who sow in tears shall reap in joy. 6 He who continually goes forth weeping, bearing seed for sowing, shall doubtless come again with rejoicing, bringing his sheaves with him.

1 Corinthians 3:5-9

Who then is Paul, and who is Apollos, but ministers through whom you believed, as the Lord gave to each one? 6 I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the increase. 7 So then neither he who plants is anything, nor he who waters, but God who gives the increase. 8 Now he who plants and he who waters are one, and each one will receive his own reward according to his own labor. 9 For we are God's fellow workers

The Joy of Telling Others About Christ

a.) *Is sowing the word of God in hope* v.39

39 And **many** of the Samaritans of that city believed in Him because of the word of the woman who testified, "He told me all that I ever did."

Jesus' Public Ministry Began in Jerusalem

with Nicodemus, He then headed for Judea where His disciples were baptizing and now He has moved into Samaria...

Acts 1:8

...and you shall be witnesses to Me in **Jerusalem**, and in all **Judea** and **Samaria**, and to the end of **the earth**."

b.) Is watching God increase its effect

v.40-41

40 So when the Samaritans had come to Him, they urged Him to stay with them; and He stayed there two days. **41** And **many more** believed **because of His own word.**

c.) Is harvesting what God has done

v.42

42 Then they said to the woman, "Now we believe, not because of what you said, for we ourselves have heard Him **and we know** that this is indeed the Christ, **the Savior of the world.**"

**By Addressing Her
They honored Her and Her Testimony
the Savior of the world**

1 Timothy 4:9-10

This is a faithful saying and worthy of all acceptance. 10 For to this end we both labor and suffer reproach, because we trust in the living God, who is the Savior of all men, especially of those who believe.
