Jesus gives us His bread of life teaching for this one key purpose, man is hungry and he is by nature unfulfilled and never satisfied. Jesus gave this teaching to awaken us to our modern day need of living a fulfilled, meaningful, and satisfying life.

1.) We're to rest in the divine report

vv. 37

All that the Father gives Me will come to Me, and the one who comes to Me I will **by no means cast out.**

a.) By coming into the family

v.37b

**All that the Father gives Me will come to Me
and the one who comes to Me I will by no means cast out.**

THE SECURITY OF THE BELIEVER

John 6:39

"This is the will of the Father who sent Me, that of all He has given Me I should lose nothing (or none of them)

John 17:2

"as You have given Him authority over all flesh, that He should give eternal life to as many as You have given Him.

John 17:6

"I have manifested Your name to the men whom You have given Me out of the world. They were Yours, You gave them to Me,

John 17:9

"I pray for them. I do not pray for the world but for those whom You have given Me, for they are Yours.

John Teaches about Two Biblical Truths:
The Sovereignty of God
and the Responsibility of mankind

Romans 8:28-31

And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose. 29 For whom He foreknew, He also predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren. 30 Moreover whom He predestined, these He also called; whom He called, these He also justified; and whom He justified, these He also glorified. 31 What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us?

The Sovereignty of God and the Responsibility of mankind

“How do you reconcile the two” someone asked Charles Spurgeon. Spurgeon replied. “I have never tried to reconcile it – I just believe it”

Joshua 24:15

...choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve,

1 Peter 2:7-8

Therefore, to you who believe, He is precious; but to those who are disobedient, "The stone which the builders rejected has become the chief **cornerstone**," 8 and "A **stumbling stone** - a rock of offense." They stumble, being disobedient to the word, to which they also were appointed.

b.) By keeping us in the family

v.37

will by no means cast out.

Psalm 34:18

The LORD is near to those who have a broken heart, and saves such as have a contrite spirit.

HIS KEEPING POWER

The united states military forces have been trained to never leave a man behind

Hebrews 7:24-25

But He, because He continues forever, has an unchangeable priesthood. 25 Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them.

2.) *We're to enjoy the divine relationship* vv. 38-40

"For (because) I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me. 39 "This is the will of the Father who sent Me, that of all He has given Me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up at the last day. 40 **"And this is the will of Him who sent Me, that everyone who sees the Son and believes in Him may have everlasting life; and I will raise him up at the last day."**

a.) *Enjoy what the Father thinks about you* v.38

"For (because) I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, **but the will of Him who sent Me.**

God the Father's will is that you be saved from your sins and be secured in heaven - that's why He came down !

Psalm 139:17-18

How precious also are Your thoughts to me, O God! How great is the sum of them! 18 If I should count them, they would be more in number than the sand; when I awake, I am still with You.

Jeremiah 29:11

For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the LORD, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.

An Example of the Father's Zeal for Us

John 14:2

In My Father's house

We're to enjoy the divine relationship

b.) Enjoy the Father's heart of protection

v.39

"This is the will of the Father who sent Me, **that of all He has given Me I should lose nothing**, but should raise it up at the last day.

PARENTAL PROTECTION

John 10:27-29

"My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me. 28 "And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand. 29 "My Father, who has given them to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch them out of My Father's hand.

c.) Enjoy the certainty of your future

v.40

"And this is the will of Him who sent Me, that everyone who sees the Son and believes in Him may **have everlasting life**; and I will **raise him up** at the last day."

to stare at, to gaze upon and consider

LOOK TO THE SON AND BE SAVED

Isaiah 45:22

"Look to Me, and be saved, all you ends of the earth! For I am God, and there is no other.

Resurrection Promise

John 11:21-25

3.) We're to know the divine realization ***vv. 41-47***

a.) Know what you believe about Jesus ***v.41-42***

41 The Jews then complained about Him, because He said, "I am the bread which came down from heaven." 42 And they said, "Is not this Jesus, the son of Joseph, whose father and mother we know? How is it then that He says, 'I have come down from heaven'?"

The religious Jews were completely baffled

*The Forever Bread, coming down from heaven
Was a direct claim of deity*

Complainedgrk 1111 gogguzo (gong-good'-zo);
to grumble: to murmur. To whine, to protest at the expense of
time and effort

Stop It, The Murmuring, Griping, Complaining

- Never did Joseph ever claim that Jesus was his son
- Never did Mary ever claim that Jesus was ever Joseph's son
- And Never did Jesus ever claim that He was the son of Joseph

- But the angels did claim that Jesus was God's only Son
- The prophets claimed that Jesus was God's only Son
- God the Father claimed that Jesus was His only Son
- The Bible claims that Jesus is God's only Son

Know What You Believe

b.) Know why you believe in Jesus

v.43-45

Jesus therefore answered and said to them, "Do not murmur among yourselves. 44 **"No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him;** and I will raise him up at the last day. 45 "It is written in the prophets, 'And they shall all be taught by God.' Therefore everyone who has heard and learned from the Father comes to Me.

Only Those Who Will Listen Will Experience Salvation,
And you're not listening so don't worry about it

IS THERE A "DRAWING" TAKING PLACE IN YOUR LIFE?

Have you been fully persuaded ?

The Jews were complaining about the chance of people following Jesus. Jesus says to them 'Just Stop it' !!!

No One Can Follow Me Unless My Father Puts It In His Heart

Jeremiah 31:3

The LORD has appeared of old to me, saying: "Yes, I have loved you with an everlasting love; therefore with lovingkindness I have drawn you.

Verse 45

"It is written in the prophets, 'And they shall all be taught by God.' Therefore everyone who has heard and learned from the Father comes to Me.

We're to know the divine realization

c.) Know where your faith in Jesus is

v.46-47

"Not that anyone has seen the Father, except He who is from God; He has seen the Father. 47 "Most assuredly, I say to you, **he who believes in Me** has everlasting life.

Most assuredly, I say to you
(often said when He's not being believed)

The Ticket to Paradise and Nothing Else

he who believes in Me

believes grk 4100 pisteuo (pist-yoo'-o);
to put faith in, upon, or to entrust with another

4.) We're to possess the divine revelation

vv. 48-51

48 "I am the bread of life. 49 "Your fathers ate the manna in the wilderness, and are dead. 50 "This is the bread which comes down from heaven, that one may eat of it and not die. 51 "I am the living bread which came down from heaven. If anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever; and the bread that I shall give is My flesh, which I shall give for the life of the world

a.) Possess death-defying life

v. 48-50

48 "**I am the bread of life.** 49 "Your fathers ate the manna in the wilderness, and are dead. 50 "This is the bread which comes down from heaven, that one may **eat of it and not die**

“the manna only filled your tummies for that day
and that day only but eventually they all died anyway”

the bread of life (manna couldn't sustain life) fills your entire life, body (in the resurrection)
soul (the mental faculties) and spirit (the actual state of being) with age-defying life

to **eat of it**

There are two words for eat in the original Greek scripture

Verse 48-51

The word eat or ate is a word that relates back to the Old Testament sacrifice that was consumed upon the altar of sacrifice.

An animal sacrifice as a burnt offering

But also there are sacrifices in the Old Testament that you are commanded to eat and to enjoy

Psalm 34:8

Oh, taste and see that the LORD is good;

" E a t i n g " a s i n F e l l o w s h i p

Luke 22:29-30

"And I bestow upon you a kingdom, just as My Father bestowed one upon Me, 30 "that you may eat and drink at My table in My kingdom..."

Eating and Drinking to a Jew Was an invitation of fellowship with another

To eat and drink
is to agree with another regarding the sacrifice that is being offered

We're to possess the divine revelation

b.) Possess age-abiding life

v.51

"I am the living bread which came down from heaven. If anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever; and the bread that I shall give is My flesh, which I shall give for the life of the world

If anyone eats (this is the 2nd Word)

The Greek means a single meal that you eat once in time, never again!
Like a Sacrifice that is placed upon the altar and consumed by the fires once and for all

John 10:10

I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.

5.) *We're to experience the divine reception* vv. 52-59

The Jews therefore quarreled among themselves, saying, "How can this Man give us His flesh to eat?" 53 Then Jesus said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in you. 54 **"Whoever eats My flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life,** and I will raise him up at the last day. 55 "For My flesh is food indeed, and My blood is drink indeed. 56 "He who eats My flesh and drinks My blood abides in Me, and I in him 57 "As the living Father sent Me, and I live because of the Father, so he who feeds on Me will live because of Me. 58 "This is the bread which came down from heaven-- not as your fathers ate the manna, and are dead. He who eats this bread will live forever." 59 These things He said in the synagogue as He taught in Capernaum.

a.) *By making Jesus personal* v. 52-53

The Jews therefore quarreled among themselves, saying, "How can this Man give us His flesh to eat?" 53 Then Jesus said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, **unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood,** you have no life in you.

Receiving Christ's FULL-ness to your benefit

No sipping, No tasting, No sampling

But a deep, full, and complete consumption of the person Jesus

To know Him fully as your Savoir, Messiah, King, Lord, and God

Then Jesus said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, **unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood,** you have no life in you.

james boice

“is He as real to you as something that you would eat or handle? is Jesus Christ as real to you the american christian as hamburger and french fries are to your stomach? of course Jesus is far greater than these, but many professing believers think of him much less.”

Jesus Christ is not a popular snack

Can I Have a Happy Meal with That?

Jesus Christ is the eternal food for life

Don't Just Sip or Taste of Jesus

2 Peter 2:21

For it would have been better for them not to have known the way of righteousness, than having known it, to turn from it...

Sipping or Tasting

Hebrews 6:4-6

For it is impossible for those who were once enlightened, and have **tasted** the heavenly gift, and have become **partakers** of the Holy Spirit, 5 and have **tasted** the good word of God and the powers of the age to come, 6 if they fall away, to renew them again to repentance, since they crucify again for themselves the Son of God, and put Him to an open shame.

There are sippers and nibblers in the church

That can describe the taste, the smell, the feel, the sound but that is as far as their relationship with God goes - they are recreational believers, attendees, armchair Christians, pew potatoes

*- But rather, have you Digested Him into your
Innermost Being
Consumed of Him to the Fullest?*

We're to experience the divine reception

b.) *Be given to all who will accept Him*

v.54-56

54 **"Whoever** eats My flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day. 55 "For My flesh is food indeed, and My blood is drink indeed. 56 "He who (keeps on) eats My flesh and drinks My blood abides in Me, and I in him

Be given to all who will accept Him

c.) Reception of Jesus is a true experience v. 57-59

57 "As the living Father sent Me, and I live because of the Father, **so he who feeds on Me will live because of Me.** 58 "This is the bread which came down from heaven - not as your fathers ate the manna, and are dead. He who eats this bread will live forever." 59 These things He said in the synagogue as He taught in Capernaum.

so he who **feeds** on Me will live

a word that means to be nourished - constantly be
eating

Exodus 20:3

"You shall have no other gods before Me.
(that's in the negative)

Exodus 20:3

"You shall have Me!
(that's in the positive)

- I want to be bread to you
- I want to be water to you

- I want to be joy to you
- I want to be peace to you
- I want to be love to you

Revelation 22:13
