Reading of the Text

The Summation Sentence

Jesus had been clearly successful in communicating to the people that He himself had come down from heaven. He had made it undeniably clear that He was the very source of eternal life. All that Jesus had said and did announced that He was God's messiah. This the common people began to embrace. But as soon as Jesus pressed the side of human responsibility toward knowing God and that it meant that all mankind needed Him, this many of them could not receive. Jesus had become a threat!

Disbelief

Is unlike unbelief. Unbelief is rooted in the fact that someone cannot see what is plainly before them. Disbelief is being confronted with what is true of the facts only to willfully reject that witness.

The Issue Before Us is that of Disbelief

And it is all the more bizarre when you consider the fact that Jesus Christ was standing right in front of them. Could it be that in your life, Jesus has always been right in front of you?

The Dangers of Disbelief

Disbelief robs from the apparent

a.) It's blind to justice

After these things Jesus walked in Galilee; for He did not want to walk in Judea. because the Jews sought to kill Him.

After these things

(the teaching on the bread, the blood, and the disciples)

Verse 1

Jesus walked in **Galilee** for He did not want to walk in **Judea**,

the Jews sought to kill Him

BLIND TO JUSTICE

Isaiah 53:3

He is despised and rejected by men, a Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief. And we hid, as it were, our faces from Him; he was despised, and we did not esteem Him.

Jesus was now guilty and is a wanted man we're now six months away from His crucifixion at this point

DISBELIEF RESENTED HIM !!!

b.) It corrupts the truth

vv. 2-4

Now the Jews' Feast of Tabernacles was at hand. 3 His brothers therefore said to Him, "Depart from here and go into Judea, that Your disciples also may see the works that You are doing. 4 "For no one does anything in secret while he himself seeks to be known openly. If You do these things, show Yourself to the world."

Now the Jews' Feast of Tabernacles was at hand

The truth was, Israel was about to celebrate the greatest of all its festivals

The feast of tabernacles was one of the three great feasts of the Jewish calendar. Following the feast of trumpets and the Day of Atonement, the feast of tabernacles was when the nation left the comfort of their homes and would camp out together in hand-made tents. The tents would be open at the top which would let in the starry sky at night and the light of the sun by day. This was all done in celebration of their forefathers wilderness wanderings in the desert for some 40 years. It was a joyous time that required that all devout Jewish males make the pilgrimage to Jerusalem.

And in Jerusalem, The Temple area was illuminated with large menorah's that would symbolize the pillar of fire that kept the people by night in the desert

It was an intense time of remembrance and reflection of what God had done

Children; Tell Them the Story

Deuteronomy 6:4-7

"Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one! 5 "You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength. 6 "And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart. 7 "You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up.

The Psalms were read and shouted throughout Jerusalem

Implied in the brother's language is mockery Not Unlike Joseph and His Brothers

Self Promotion is of Satanic Origins

Verse 4

For no one does anything in secret while **he himself seeks to be known** openly. If You do these things, show Yourself to the world."

In other words; "Hey Jesus, It pays to advertise"

Matthew 4:3

Now when the tempter came to Him, he said, "If You are the Son of God, command that these stones become bread... "If You are the Son of God, throw Yourself down... "All these things I will give You if You will fall down and worship me."

Just on the Heels of Many Disciples Leaving Him, ISN'T IT JUST LIKE SATAN TO PIPE UP AND SING THE BLUES

Disbelief robs from the apparent

c.) It resists reality

vv. 5

Verse 5

For even His brothers did not believe in Him. His brothers did not believe in Him

This is the reason why they egged Him on to go out and risk His life, They didn't believe in Him !!!

A sad but prophetic fulfillment

Psalm 69:8 I have become a stranger to my brothers, and an alien to my mother's children;

an alien to my mother's children

They didn't believe in Him because they had missed the scriptures But they are eager to do the religious routine and practice the traditions without the knowledge of the truth

Matthew 13:55-56

"Is this not the carpenter's son? Is not His mother called Mary? And His brothers James, Joses, Simon, and Judas? 56 "And His sisters, are they not all with us? Where then did this Man get all these things?"

Mark 6:3-4

"Is this not the carpenter, the Son of Mary, and brother of James, Joses, Judas, and Simon? And are not His sisters here with us?" And they were offended at Him. 4 But Jesus said to them, "A prophet is not without honor except in his own country, among his own relatives, and in his own house." *

brother of

grk 80 adephos (ad-el-fos');

a near reletive, a sibbling, to be of the same womb. to share the same womb

They had been womb mates !!!

how is it

that His brothers and sisters could have grown up rejecting the message that surrounded their half-brother Jesus, rejecting their father Joseph's account, of their mother Mary, the law and prophets of the old testament, even Jesus' own words and works?

2 Corinthians 13:5 **Examine** (scrutinize) yourselves as to whether you are in the faith. **Test** (judge against the standard) yourselves.

A side note here ...

The Bible here clearly discredits the false teaching that Mary didn't have any more children other than Jesus and that she was a perpetual virgin being married to Joseph

Matthew 1:22-25

So all this was done that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the Lord through the prophet, saying: 23 "Behold, the virgin shall be with child, and bear a Son, and they shall call His name Immanuel," which is translated, "God with us." 24 Then Joseph, being aroused from sleep, did as the angel of the Lord commanded him and took to him his wife, 25 and **did not know her until** she had brought forth her firstborn Son. - Jesus.

b.) Compromise cannot take a stand

vv. 7

"The world cannot hate you, but it hates Me because I testify of it that its works are evil.

J.C. Ryle put it this way

"They could have and would have tolerated any thing but this. Rejecting Him as messiah and ignoring Him and His miracles they could do, and do with proficiency. But it was His holy proximity to their sinful lives that they could not stand any longer." Hebrews 12:14 Pursue peace with all people, and **holiness**, without which no one will see the Lord:

1 Peter 3:15 But sanctify (set him apart – not aside) the Lord God in your hearts,

Compromise

is the chameleon of the soul

it's like trying to hold water it's like attempting to be politically correct

Matthew 5:12-13

Rejoice and be glad, for your reward is great in heaven, for so men persecuted the prophets who were before you. 13 "You are the salt of the earth; but if you lose your saltiness... (compromise)

c.) Compromise leads to hypocrisy

vv. 8

"You go up to this feast. I am not yet going up to this feast, for My time has not yet fully come."

"I am not yet going up to this feast"

John 7:8 You go on, and I'll come later when it is the right time."

They were going to worship "God" according to the Bible But couldn't recognize Him even though He stood in front of them

a.)	By refusing His presence	vv. 9

When He had said these things to them, He remained in Galilee

When the men had come to Him, they said, "John the Baptist has sent us to You, saying, 'Are You the Coming One, or do we look for another?'" 21 And that very hour He cured many of infirmities, afflictions, and evil spirits; and to many blind He gave sight. 22 Then Jesus answered and said to them, "Go and tell John the things you have seen and heard: that the blind see, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, the poor have the gospel preached to them. 23 "And blessed is he who is not offended because of Me."

b.) By veiling His glory

vv. 10

But when His brothers had gone up, then He also went up to the feast, **not openly**, **but as it were in secret.**

Disbelief looks in to the face of truth and refuses to see its glory

Disbelief keeps us from His blessings

c.) By removing the hope of heaven

The Signs of Disbelief

(Remembering that disbelief is different from unbelief)

#1 – A self-confident attitude regarding spiritual matters – *proud!*

- #2 A willingness to not want to know or to learn obstinate!
- #3 An inability to submit to authority *rebellious!*
- #4 A resistance to divine change inflexible!
- #5 A desire to go back to the old life *unconverted!*

always remember this grave warning

"My brethren, let not many of you become teachers, Instructors in the word, knowing that those who do teach the Bible shall receive a stricter judgment in the end when they stand before God."
