**Time is Running Out!**

**1.) When you begin to attack Jesus Christ**

**vv. 48-50**

Then the Jews answered and said to Him, "Do we not say rightly that You are a Samaritan and have a demon?"

## The "Then"

### Verse 52

*Then the Jews said to Him,  
"Now we know that You have a demon!"*

### Verse 57

*Then the Jews said to Him,  
"You are not yet fifty years old, and have You seen Abraham?"*

### Verse 59

*Then they took up stones to throw at Him*

#1

You are a **Samaritan** (armk: show-mer-o-nee)

#2

and have a **demon?**" (armk: show-mer-on)

The Jews Taught That  
Samaritans Were Of The Devil and Demonic

You are a child of satan, (samaritan) and you are demonic  
(heretic)

This is what they believed

Proverbs 28:14  
But he who hardens his heart  
will fall into calamity.

## Good Evil and Evil Good

“I never talk about politics and religion”  
- - but they will talk about Jesus (\$#%^^^%&##@#@)

**b.) You begin to be ashamed of Him**

**v.49-50**

49 Jesus answered, **"I do not have a demon; but I honor My Father, and you dishonor Me. 50 And I do not seek My own glory; there is One who seeks and judges.**

and you dishonor Me.**

**dishonor**

grk atimazo (at-im-ad'-zo)

to hold in contempt. To despise, to suffer with shame, or to be shameful about a person

“I don't want to be seen with them in public”  
embarrassed due to association

## **PAUL THE APOSTLE'S "B.C." DAYS**

Romans 1:16

For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek.

**Verse 50**

**And I do not seek My own glory;  
there is One who seeks and judges.**

<<He will judge all those who dishonor Jesus>>

**2.) When you begin to discard His Word vv. 51-55**

**a.) Because His Word is Life v.51**

**Most assuredly, I say to you, if anyone keeps My word  
he shall never see death."**

**he shall never see death."**

God Alone was the God Over Death.

They thought Jesus was speaking of physical death

*Which He is the lord over that too*

**SPIRITUAL DEATH**

**if anyone keeps My word**

(hang on to it, stay close to it, make it your meal, your drink)

**Time is Running Out!**

**b.) Because His Word is Clear v.52-53**

Then the Jews said to Him, "Now we know that You have a demon! Abraham is dead, and the prophets; and You say, 'If anyone keeps My word he shall never taste death.' 53 "Are You greater than our father Abraham, who is dead? And the prophets are dead. Whom do You make Yourself out to be?"

## Regarding Physical Death

Abraham died, the prophets died

## Time is Running Out!

*When you begin to discard His Word*

**c.) Because His Word is Authoritative**

**v.54-55**

54 Jesus answered, "If I honor Myself, My honor is nothing. It is My Father who honors Me, of whom you say that He is your God. 55 Yet you have not known Him, but I know Him. And if I say, 'I do not know Him,' I shall be a liar like you; but I do know Him and keep His word.

**It is My Father who honors Me,**

**honor** grk doxazo (dox-ad'-zo);

to render or to give glory to. To esteem highly. To respect and to show reverence for.

John 17:5

And now, O Father, glorify Me together with Yourself, with the glory which I had with You before the world was.

John 14:10-11

Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? The words that I speak to you I do not speak on My own authority; but the Father who dwells in Me does the works. Believe Me that I am in the Father and the Father in Me, **or else believe Me for the sake of the works themselves.**

Matthew 3:16-17

16 When He had been baptized, Jesus came up immediately from the water; and behold, the heavens were opened to Him, and He saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting upon Him. 17 And suddenly a voice came from heaven, saying, "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased."

**3.) When you begin to see Jesus as less vv. 56-58**

**a.) When He is the Eternal One v.56-57**

**Your father Abraham (2100bc) rejoiced to see My day, and he saw it and was glad." Then the Jews said to Him, "You are not yet fifty years old, and have You seen Abraham?"**

**There are Several Views on What This Means**

## From paradise, Abraham saw

### **Luke 16:23-25**

24 Then he cried and said, 'Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus that he may dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame.' 25 But Abraham said, 'Son, remember that in your lifetime you received your good things, and likewise Lazarus evil things; but now he is comforted and you are tormented.'

## In a Vision, Abraham saw

### **Genesis 15:1-2**

15:1 After these things the word of the LORD came to Abram in a vision, saying, "Do not be afraid, Abram. I am your shield, your exceedingly great reward."

## Face to Face, Abraham saw

### **Genesis 18:1-4**

18:1 Then the LORD appeared to him by the terebinth trees of Mamre, as he was sitting in the tent door in the heat of the day. 2 So he lifted his eyes and looked, and behold, three men were standing by him; and when he saw them, he ran from the tent door to meet them, and bowed himself to the ground, 3 and said, "My Lord, if I have now found favor in Your sight, do not pass on by Your servant. (theophanes – christophanes)

## Again - Face to Face, Abraham saw

### **Genesis 18:12-15**

12 Therefore Sarah laughed within herself, saying, "After I have grown old, shall I have pleasure, my lord being old also?" 13 And the LORD said to Abraham, "Why did Sarah laugh, saying, 'Shall I surely bear a child, since I am old?' 14 "Is anything too hard for the LORD? At the appointed time I will return to you, according to the time of life, and Sarah shall have a son." 15 But Sarah denied it, saying, "I did not laugh," for she was afraid. And He said, "No, but you did laugh!"

## Through the Eye of Faith, Abraham saw

### **Hebrews 11:17-20**

17 By faith Abraham, when he was tested, offered up Isaac, and he who had received the promises offered up his only begotten son, 18 of whom it was said, "In Isaac your seed shall be called," 19 concluding that God was able to raise him up, even from the dead, from which he also received him in a figurative sense.

**b.) When He is King of Kings and Lord of Lords v.58**

Jesus said to them, "**Most assuredly, I say to you, before Abraham was, I AM.**"

**I AM**

Before Abraham's birth, I was, I am, and shall always be  
(ETERNAL)

before anything was ever created, before time began,  
before angels existed,

John 1:1-3

1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.  
2 He was in the beginning with God. 3 All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made.

I HAVE ALWAYS BEEN, I AM BEING NOW, AND SHALL NEVER END

## This is What They Clearly Understood Jesus to Say

Isaiah 57:15

For thus says the High and Lofty One  
Who inhabits eternity, whose name is Holy:

Micah 5:2

2 "But you, Bethlehem,  
...out of you shall come forth to Me The One to be Ruler in Israel, Whose goings forth  
are from of old, From everlasting."

Revelation 19:11-16

### **4.) *When you begin to resist the Holy Spirit* vv. 59**

**Then** they took up stones to throw at Him; but Jesus hid Himself and went out of the temple, going through the midst of them, and so passed by.

### **a.) *They Resisted His Claims* v.59**

Acts 7:51-52

"You stiffnecked and uncircumcised in heart and ears! You always resist the Holy Spirit; as your fathers did, so do you. 52 Which of the prophets did your fathers not persecute?"

contamination, pollution, poison, soul sickness

Hebrews 12:12-16

12 Therefore strengthen the hands which hang down, and the feeble knees, 13 and make straight paths for your feet, so that what is lame may not be dislocated, but rather be healed. 14 Pursue peace with all people, and holiness, without which no one will see the Lord: 15 looking diligently lest anyone fall short of the grace of God; lest any root of **bitterness** springing up cause trouble, and by this many become defiled;

Romans 3:9-18

10 As it is written: "There is none righteous, no, not one; 11 There is none who understands; There is none who seeks after God. 12 They have all turned aside; They have together become unprofitable; There is none who does good, no, not one." 13 "Their throat is an open tomb; With their tongues they have practiced deceit"; "The poison of asps is under their lips"; 14 "Whose mouth is full of cursing and **bitterness**." 15 "Their feet are swift to shed blood; 16 Destruction and misery are in their ways; 17 And the way of peace they have not known." 18 "There is no fear of God before their eyes."

John 8:2-5

3 Then the scribes and Pharisees brought to Him a woman caught in adultery. And when they had set her in the midst, 4 they said to Him, "Teacher, this woman was caught in adultery, in the very act. 5 Now Moses, in the law, commanded us that such should be stoned. But what do You say?"

**They Had The Stones in Hand**

Luke 11:23

He who is not with Me is against Me,  
and he who does not gather with Me scatters.

John 3:16-20

16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. 17 For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved. 18 He who believes in Him is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. 19 And this is the condemnation, that the light has come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil.
