1.) Jesus Christ is Unique in History

vv. 31-32

Then the Jews took up stones again to stone Him. 32 Jesus answered them, "Many good works I have shown you from My Father.

For which of those works do you stone Me?"

a.) He was Unfairly Rejected

V.31

Then the Jews took up stones again to stone Him.

The "Then" Here is Referring to Jesus' Announcement in Verses 25 to 30

Their M.O. <u>At Before Abraham was I AM...</u>

John 8:59
Then they took up stones to throw at Him; but

THEIR MOTIVES WERE WRONG &

Their unbelief and actions convicted them

Verse 25

The works that "I do"

they bear witness of Me

His Works Were **Physical Indictments** Against Them

"I told" you,

and you do not believe.

His Words Were a **Logical Indictment** Against Them

"My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and **they follow Me.**

"they follow Me."

His Authority Was a **Practical Indictment** Against Them

Verse 28

And "I give them" eternal life

and they shall never perish;

(double negative in the greek)

His Deity Was The **Spiritual Indictment** Against Them

Verse 29-30

"I and My Father are one."

"My Father, who has given *them* to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch *them* out of $\mathcal{M}_{\boldsymbol{y}}$ Father's hand.

"I and My Father are one."

Way Back in the Old Testament, God Revealed Himself to Moses

Exodus 3:13-14

Then Moses said to God, "Indeed, when I come to the children of Israel and say to them, 'The God of your fathers has sent me to you,' and they say to me, 'What is His name?' what shall I say to them?" 14 And God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM." And He said, "Thus you shall say to the children of Israel, 'I AM has sent me to you."

Here in the New Testament – Jesus Reveals Himself as God

John 8:23-24

And He said to them, "You are from beneath; I am from above. You are of this world; I am not of this world. 24 "Therefore I said to you that you will die in your sins; for if you do not believe that **I am**, you will die in your sins."

John 8:58-59

Jesus said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, before Abraham was, I AM." 59 Then they took up stones to throw at Him;

This Truth, That Jesus is The Lord God, is The Christian Essential of the Bible That separates Biblically, Saving Christianity Apart from Aberrant Christian Views and the Doctrines of Demons Found in the Door to Door Teachings of the Cults.

If Jesus' Teachings on This Subject So Generated Anger Among His Audience, Then There Must Be an Equal Reaction Today When This Truth is Proclaimed

Exodus 20:3

"You shall have no other gods before Me.

THE DOCTRINE OF JESUS' DEITY

Is the single most dividing truth of the Bible and it must be. It will always create a response and a reaction

This Teaching Must Be a "Non-Spectator Event"

meaning that you and I will be participating and you and I will be responding to what is taught today

AS WE EXAMINE ETERNAL TRUTH

b.) He was Guilty of Good

v.32

Jesus answered them, "Many good works I have shown you from My Father. For which of those works do you stone Me?"

"Why Are You Against What I'm Doing" when everything I AM doing is Right On

Matthew 5:14-16

"You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. 15 "Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. 16 "Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

It was not what He was Doing That Bothered Them. It was Who He Said He was

2.) Jesus Christ is Unique Today

vv. 33

The Jews answered Him, saying, "For a good work we do not stone You, but for blasphemy, and because You, being a Man, make Yourself God."

a.) What can man say about Him

v.33a

The Jews answered Him, saying, "For a good work we do not stone

they had nothing on Him- but good deeds

For a Good Work <u>They Could Not</u> Stone Him He was fulfilling all that the ancient Hebrew prophets had foretold

Psalm 40:5-7

Many, O LORD my God, are the wonders you have done. The things you planned for us no one can recount to you; were I to speak and tell of them, they would be too many to declare. 6 Sacrifice and offering you did not desire, but my ears you have pierced; burnt offerings and sin offerings you did not require. 7 Then I said, "Behold – in the volume of the book, it is written of me"

HIS WORKS CONFIRMED HIS WORDS

Matthew 11:4-5

Jesus answered and said to them, "Go and tell John the things which you hear and see: 5 "The blind see and the lame walk; the lepers are cleansed and the deaf hear; the dead are raised up and the poor have the gospel preached to them.

Was This a Coded Message to John from the Bible?

Isaiah 35:4-6

for your God is coming to save you." 5 And when he comes, he will open the eyes of the blind and unstop the ears of the deaf. 6 The lame man will leap up like a deer, and those who could not speak will shout and sing!

When John was Doubting, He Could Look Back to See What God Had Done

Jesus Christ is Unique Today

b.) What does He say about Himself

v.33b

but for blasphemy, and because You, being a Man, ake Yourself God."

They understood Him perfectly !!!

They understood Him to say that He was claiming to be God
-That would be Blasphemy if you weren't God

But He Was God so it Wasn't Blasphemy but Truth

"These verses are a series of nightmares beyond belief for any Jehovah's Witness" – William Centnar

NOTE THE GREEK HERE

Because You, being a Man, make Yourself (constantly declaring) God."

Is Jesus God ?

Isaiah 48:12

"Listen to Me, O Jacob, and Israel, My called: I am He, I am the First, I am also the Last.

Isaiah 44:6

"Thus says the LORD, the King of Israel, and his Redeemer, the LORD of hosts: 'I am the First and I am the Last; besides Me there is no God.

3.) Jesus Christ is LORD of All

vv. 34-36

34 Jesus answered them, "Is it not written in your law, 'I said, "You are gods" '? 35 "If He called them gods, to whom the word of God came (and the Scripture cannot be broken), 36 "do you say of Him whom the Father sanctified and sent into the world, 'You are blaspheming,' because I said, 'I am the Son of God'?

Psalm 82:6

I said, "You are gods, and all of you are children of the Most High.

This is the Mormons Favorite Verse

To argue for their teaching that you can become a God

As well as those who of the new age movement of self-deification

Throughout the Bible the word "Elohim" Appears. The Word "El" or "Elo" is god and "Im" means a Plurality.

Judeo-Christian Theology Agrees on this Point That both the New and Old Testament Scriptures refer to God as a singular, plurality – Were Monotheistic

The Jew, The Christian, and The Muslim Are all monotheists - believing in one God

But The Pagan World Uses The Same Word to Address Their Deities - The gods of the pagan world were referred to as Elohim(s)

Example, The Romans and the Greeks worshipped Elohim - Many deities and gods

a.) He only is LORD

v.34

Jesus answered them,
"Is it not written in your law, 'I said, "You are gods" '?

Look at The Bible in Context

(a text, taken out of context, is a pretext)
G. Campbell-Morgan

Psalm 82:1-8

God stands in the congregation of the mighty; he judges among the gods. 2 How long will you judge unjustly, (the gods) and show partiality to the wicked? 3 to Defend the poor and fatherless; do justice to the afflicted and needy. 4 Deliver the poor and needy; free them from the hand of the wicked. 5 They (the gods) do not know, nor do they (the gods) understand; they (the gods) walk about in darkness; all the foundations of the earth are unstable. 6 I said, "You are gods, and all of you are children of the Most High. 7 But you (the gods) shall die like men (common men), and fall like one of the princes." 8 Arise, O God, judge the earth; for You shall inherit all nations.

He, The Heavenly Judge, Judges the earthly Judges Who Act in His Place

Exodus 22:7-9

"If a man delivers to his neighbor money or articles to keep, and it is stolen out of the man's house, if the thief is found, he shall pay double. 8 "If the thief is not found, then the master of the house shall be brought to the (gods-elohim) judges to see whether he has put his hand into his neighbor's goods. 9 "For any kind of trespass, whether it concerns an ox, a donkey, a sheep, or clothing, or for any kind of lost thing which another claims to be his, the cause of both parties shall come before the (gods-elohim) judges; and whomever the (gods-elohim) judges condemn shall pay double to his neighbor.

Exodus 18:19-22

"Listen now to my voice; I will give you counsel, and God will be with you: Stand before God for the people, so that you may bring the difficulties to God. 20 "And you shall teach them the statutes and the laws, and show them the way in which they must walk and the work they must do. 21 "Moreover you shall select from all the people able men, such as fear God, men of truth, hating covetousness; and place such over them to be rulers of thousands, rulers of hundreds, rulers of fifties, and rulers of tens. 22 "And let them judge the people at all times.

Jesus is Saying This

"if you guys call yourselves gods (rulers or lords) and you have no problem with that – then after all that you have seen me do, how can you have a problem understanding that I am THE God?"

> You Say That You are authorities But I say to You – I am The Authority

4.) Jesus Christ is Savior

vv. 37-42

"If I do not do the works of My Father, do not believe Me; 38 "but if I do, though you do not believe Me, believe the works, that you may know and believe that the

Father is in Me, and I in Him." 39 Therefore they sought again to seize Him, but He escaped out of their hand. 40 And He went away again beyond the Jordan to the place where John was baptizing at first, and there He stayed. 41 Then many came to Him and said, "John performed no sign, but all the things that John spoke about this Man were true." 42 And many believed in Him there.

a.) Refusing Condemns a man

v.37-39

"If I do not do the works of My Father, do not believe Me; 38 "but if I do, though you do not believe Me, believe the works, that you may know and believe that the Father is in Me, and I in Him." ." 39 Therefore they sought again to seize Him, but He escaped out of their hand

b.) Receiving Forgives a man

v.40-42

40 And He went away again beyond the Jordan to the place where John was baptizing at first, and there He stayed. 41 Then many came to Him and said, "John performed no sign, but all the things that John spoke about this Man were true." 42 And many believed in Him there.

John 1:28-34

These things were done in Bethabara beyond the Jordan, where John was baptizing. 29 The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, "Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world! 30 "This is He of whom I said, 'After me comes a Man who is preferred before me, for He was before me.' 31 "I did not know Him; but that He should be revealed to Israel, therefore I came baptizing with water." 32 And John bore witness, saying, "I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and He remained upon Him. 33 "I did not know Him, but He who sent me to baptize with water said to me, 'Upon whom you see the Spirit descending, and remaining on Him, this is He who baptizes with the Holy Spirit.' 34 "And I have seen and testified that this is the Son of God."
