1.) *Know **What** The Scripture Says*

vv. 12-13

12 The next day a great multitude that had come to the feast, when they heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem, 13 they took branches of palm trees and went out to meet Him, and cried out: "Hosanna! 'Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!' The King of Israel!"

a.) It Was The Time of Passover

v.12a

The next day a great multitude that had come to the feast
Jerusalem was in it's Glory

(Pilgrims have gathered from around the ancient world)

The Commemoration of God's Deliverance from Egypt and
it's Slavery was their Joy to Celebrate!!!

Placed Upon the mezuzah (mez-oo-zaw'); from the same as 2123;
a door-post (as prominent):

Exodus 12:13

'Now the blood shall be a sign for you on the houses where you are. And when I see the blood, I will pass over you; and the plague shall not be on you to destroy you when I strike the land of Egypt.

Leviticus 16:7-10

7 "He shall take the two goats and present them before the LORD at the door of the tabernacle of meeting. 8 "Then Aaron shall cast lots for the two goats: one lot for the LORD and the other lot for the scapegoat. 9 "And Aaron shall bring the goat on which the LORD'S lot fell, and offer it as a sin offering. 10 "But the goat on which the lot fell to be the scapegoat shall be presented alive before the LORD, to make atonement upon it, and to let it go as the scapegoat into the wilderness.

Leviticus 16:20-22

John 12:9-11

9 Now a great many of the Jews knew that He was there; and they came, not for Jesus' sake only, but that they might also see Lazarus, whom He had raised from the dead. 10 But the chief priests plotted to put Lazarus to death also, 11 because on account of him many of the Jews went away and believed in Jesus.

Why Did They Take Palm Branches?

Psalms 118:19-26

Open to me the gates of righteousness; I will go through them, and I will praise the LORD. 20 This is the gate of the LORD, through which the righteous shall enter. 21 I will praise You, for You have answered me, and have become my salvation. 22 The stone which the builders rejected has become the chief cornerstone. 23 This was the LORD'S doing; it is marvelous in our eyes. 24 This is the day the LORD has made; we will rejoice and be glad in it. 25 Save now, I pray, O LORD; O LORD, **I pray, send now prosperity.** 26 Blessed is he who comes in the name of the LORD! We have blessed you from the house of the LORD.

2.) Know *Why* The Scriptures Say It vv. 14-16

14 Then Jesus, when He had found a young donkey, sat on it; as it is written: 15 "Fear not, daughter of Zion; behold, your King is coming, sitting on a donkey's colt." 16 His disciples did not understand these things at first; but when Jesus was glorified, then they remembered that these things were written about Him and that they had done these things to Him.

a.) That We Might *Know* The Truth v.14-15

Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!" 39 And some of the Pharisees called to Him from the crowd, "Teacher, rebuke Your disciples." 40 But He answered and said to them, "I tell you that if these should keep silent, the stones would immediately cry out."

Joel 1:11-12

Be ashamed, you farmers, wail, you vinedressers, for the wheat and the barley; because the harvest of the field has perished. 12 The vine has dried up, and the fig tree has withered; the pomegranate tree, the palm tree also, and the apple tree-- all the trees of the field are withered; surely joy has withered away from the sons of men.

I am mourning; astonishment has taken hold of me.

This Past Friday I Stood,

At the Southern Section of the Western Wall in Jerusalem, this was Uncovered on a Stone in Hebrew...

Isaiah 66:14

Now when you see this, your heart shall rejoice, and your bones shall flourish like grass; the hand of the LORD shall be known to His servants, and His indignation to His against all her foes.

Matthew 24:1-2

Then Jesus when he went out and departed from the temple area, His disciples came up to Him to show Him the buildings of the temple. 2 And Jesus said to them, "Do you not see all these things? Assuredly, I say to you, not one stone shall be left here upon another, that shall not be thrown down."

"Here at this spot of the southern steps of the second temple period, Roman General Titus Aspagian and the Roman 7th Legion attacked Jerusalem and the Temple Mount was laid waste. These massive stones remain of what was "**hurled down**" in the year 70 ad." -Israel Archeology Authority

What Do You Really Know For Sure?

Daniel 9:24-27

"Seventy weeks (490) are determined for your people and for your holy city, (1) to finish the transgression, (2) to make an end of sins, (3) to make reconciliation for iniquity, (4) to bring in everlasting righteousness, (5) to seal up vision and prophecy, and (6) to anoint the Most Holy.

That is the Prophetic Plan

25 "**Know** therefore and **understand**, that from the going forth of the command to restore and build Jerusalem (445 bc.) until Messiah the Prince, (Palm Sunday) there shall be seven weeks (49 years) and (plus) (434) sixty-two weeks; the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublesome times. 26 "And but after **the** (434th Segment) sixty-two weeks Messiah shall be cut off, $49 + 434 = (483 \text{ years } 173,880 \text{ days})$ but not for Himself; for the people of the prince who is to come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary. The end of it shall be with a flood (army), and till the end of the war desolations are determined. 27 Then the prince of the people shall confirm a covenant with many for (7 years) one week; but in the middle of the (7 years) week he shall bring an end to sacrifice and offerings.

Luke 19:43-44

"For days will come upon you when your enemies will build an embankment around you, surround you and close you in on every side, 44 "and level you, and your children within you, to the ground; and they will not leave in you one stone upon another, because you did not know the time of your visitation."

c.) That We Might Proclaim The Truth

v.16

His disciples did not understand these things at first; **but when Jesus was glorified** (resurrected from the dead) , **then they remembered that these things were written about Him** and that they had done these things to Him.

It is this route, this path, this classroom,
that leads us to a greater and more effective life for Jesus Christ!

Who has believed our message and to whom has the arm of the LORD been revealed?

This Was Paul's Passion In Life

1 Corinthians 15:1-8

Moreover, brethren, I declare to you the gospel which I preached to you, which also you received and in which you stand, 2 by which also you are saved, if you hold fast that word which I preached to you-- unless you believed in vain. 3 For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, 4 and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures, 5 and that He was seen by Cephas, then by the twelve. 6 After that He was seen by over five hundred brethren at once, of whom the greater part remain to the present, but some have fallen asleep. 7 After that He was seen by James, then by all the apostles. 8 Then last of all He was seen by me also, as by one born out of due time.

2 Corinthians 4:5-7

For we do not preach ourselves, but Christ Jesus the Lord, and ourselves your bondservants for Jesus' sake. 6 For it is the God who commanded light to shine out of darkness, who has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ. 7 But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellence of the power may be of God and not of us.

Preach the word! Be ready in season and out of season. Convince, rebuke, exhort, with all longsuffering and teaching. 3 For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine, but according to their own desires, because they have itching ears, they will heap up for themselves teachers; 4 and they will turn their ears away from the truth, and be turned aside to fables. 5 But you be watchful in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry.

3.) *Live **What** The Scriptures Say*

vv. 17-19

17 Therefore the people, who were with Jesus when He had called Lazarus out of his tomb and raised him from the dead, **bore witness**. 18 For this reason the people also met Him, because they heard that He had done this sign. 19 The Pharisees therefore said among themselves, "You see that you are accomplishing nothing. Look, the world has gone after Him!"

*a.) **Determine In Your Heart To Be There***

v.17

17 Therefore the people, who were with Him (Jesus) when He called Lazarus out of his tomb and raised him from the dead, **bore witness**

There are at least two Prerequisites Here

- They had been with Jesus they heard what He had taught,
- They saw what Jesus could to do with a dead man...

Those Very Prerequisites are Outcomes available To Us!

How do I bear witness of Jesus in my Life Jack?

Take the Bible seriously and then step out on a venture

What do I need to do to bear Witness?

Make yourself available and have your attitude ready!

When am I to bear Witness?

Whenever you sense that the opportunity is yours

Three Days Ago I Stood at the Southern Vomitorium of the Temple Mount

Acts 4:1-13

1 Now as they spoke to the people, the priests, the captain of the temple, and the Sadducees came upon them, 2 being greatly disturbed that they taught the people and preached in Jesus the resurrection from the dead. 3 And they laid hands on them, and put them in custody until the next day, for it was already evening. 4 However, many of those who heard the word believed; and the number of the men came to be about five thousand. 5 And it came to pass, on the next day, that their rulers, elders, and scribes, 6 as well as Annas the high priest, Caiaphas, John, and Alexander, and as many as were of the family of the high priest, were gathered together at Jerusalem. 7 And when they had set them in the midst, they asked, "By what power or by what name have you done this?" 8 Then Peter, filled with the Holy Spirit, said to them, "Rulers of the people and elders of Israel: 9 "If we this day are judged for a good deed done to a helpless man, by what means he has been made well, 10 "let it be known to you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you crucified, whom God raised from the dead, by Him this man stands here before you whole. 11 "This is the 'stone which was rejected by you builders, which has become the chief cornerstone.' 12 **"Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved."** 13 Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were uneducated and untrained men, they marveled. And they realized that they had been with Jesus.
