Without Him as Our Source We are Going Through The Motions

2 Timothy 3:5

1 Corinthians 1:27-29

But God has chosen the foolish things of the world to put to shame the wise, and God has chosen the weak things of the world to put to shame the things which are mighty; 28 and the base things of the world and the **things which are despised** God has chosen, and the things which are not, to bring to nothing the things that are, 29 that no flesh should glory in His presence.

3.) Because We Will Be Misunderstood

"And these things they will do to you because they have not known the Father nor Me.

1 Corinthians 2:14 But the natural man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; nor can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.

4.) Because We So Easily Forget

"But these things I have told you, that when the time comes, you may remember that I told you of them. And these things I did not say to you at the beginning, because I was with you.

5.) Because We Don't Always Understand

"But now I go away to Him who sent Me, and none of you asks Me, 'Where are You going?' 6 "But because I have said these things to you, sorrow has filled your heart.

(nevertheless) no matter what you think or feel about it now... ...The Truth is This

And The Truth is This;

"It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you."

For the last three and half years He had taught them to stay close to Him

(the paradoxical teachings of Jesus Christ)

- If You Want To Be First, You Need To Be Last.
- If You Want To Be Great, Be A Servant To All.
- If You Want To Be Rich, Give Back To God.
- If You Want To Find Your Life, You Must Lose Your Life.
- If You Want To Live, Then Come And Die.

b.) Because the work is God's v.8

"And when He has come,

He will convict the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:

The Three-fold Functions Of the Holy Spirit in the World Today

"of sin, because they do not believe in Me;

9 - "of sin,

because they do not believe in Me;

sin, singular.

The sin of not believing in Jesus Christ if you want to offend the Holy Spirit today then what you must do is live this life under your own control. You must demand your own way, you must neglect the constant witnessing of the Holy Spirit. You must maintain your position until one of two things happen;

#1

you harden your heart so often to Him that you no longer have any thoughts of God

and/or #2

you suddenly die and enter eternity without Him

TO COMMIT THE UNPARDONABLE SIN Is to sin against the Holy Spirit's witness of Jesus Christ

Matthew 12:31-32 "Therefore I say to you, every sin and blasphemy will be forgiven men, but the blasphemy against the Spirit will not be forgiven men. 32 "Anyone who speaks a word against the Son of Man, it will be forgiven him; but whoever speaks against the Holy Spirit, it will not be forgiven him, either in this age or in the age to come.

Mark 3:28-29 "Assuredly, I say to you, all sins will be forgiven the sons of men, and whatever blasphemies they may utter; 29 "but he who blasphemes against the Holy Spirit shall never has forgiveness, but is subject to eternal damnation"--

The Day of Pentecost Confirmed His Return to Heaven

Matthew 28:16-20

Then the eleven disciples went away into Galilee, to the mountain which Jesus had appointed for them. 17 When they saw Him, they worshiped Him; but some doubted.
18 And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. 19 "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations"

Authority / Power

1849 exousia (ex-oo-see'-ah);

The privilege, the ability, the freedom, the influence, God given rights

We have been given the *ABILITY*

We have been given the *FREEDOM*

We have been given the *INFLUENCE*

We have been given the *GOD-GIVEN RIGHT*

The Authority Is

the God-given appointment to proclaim the Gospel to the world

Luke 9:1-2

Then He called His disciples together He gave them power and authority... 2 and He sent them to **preach the kingdom of God**

7.) Because He Teaches us the Truth

vv. 12-13

"I still have many things to say to you, but you cannot bear them now. 13 "However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come.

"I still have many things to say to you,

but you cannot bear them now"

(= wait till the Holy Spirit gets here)

It is the Holy Spirit That Grants to Every Believer A divine insight or knowledge.

The Indwelling of the Holy Spirit in the life of the Christian Is often an uneventful coming

So Calm and Still

That the new believer is tempted to think nothing has happened at all
