1.) Comes to us unexpectedly

vv. 1-2

a.) Unexpectedly - The Cross Begins in the garden v.1

When Jesus had spoken these words, He went out with His disciples over the Brook Kidron, where there was a garden , which He and His disciples entered....

"WHEN"

All had been said, that needed to be said

## Jesus had finished His words

### a garden,

which He and His disciples entered....

Luke 22:39 Coming out, He went to the Mount of Olives, as He was accustomed, and His disciples also followed Him.

# a place of peaceful fellowship even unto this day

Apparently this is What God Enjoys; "A Garden of Fellowship"

### **A Meeting Place Where God is Experienced**

- Do you have a place that you can talk to God?
- Do you have a place that you can cry to God?
- Do you have a place that you can worship God?

### CHRISTIAN You Must Have a Garden and You Must Defend It

if there's a place on earth that could haunt God, if there's a place of remembrance that could send a bitter chill to His heart, it's "GARDENS"

Genesis 3:1-9

1 Now the serpent was more cunning than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said to the woman, "Has God indeed said, 'You shall not eat of every tree of the garden'?" 2 And the woman said to the serpent, "We may eat the fruit of the trees of the garden; 3 "but of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God has said, 'You shall not eat it, nor shall you touch it, lest you die.'" 4 Then the serpent said to the woman, "You will not surely die. 5 "For God knows that in the day you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil." 6 So when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree desirable to make one wise, she took of its fruit and ate. She also gave to her husband with her, and he ate. 7 Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves coverings. 8 And they heard the sound of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God among the trees of the garden. 9 Then the LORD God called to Adam and said to him, "Where are you?"
