2nd Corinthians 10:1-6

2 Cor. 10:1-6

Now I, Paul, myself am pleading with you by the meekness and gentleness of Christ - who in presence am lowly among you, but being absent am bold toward you. 2 But I beg you that when I am present I may not be bold with that confidence by which I intend to be bold against some, who think of us as if we walked according to the flesh. 3 For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh. 4 For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for (1) pulling down strongholds, 5 (2) casting down arguments and (3) every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, (4) bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ, 6 and (5) being ready to punish all disobedience when your obedience is fulfilled.

For though we walk in the flesh,

walk	περιπατέω peripateo, per-ee-pat-eh´-o; to tread all about, to walk at large, to transport oneself or export oneself, to be preoccupied with self interests.
flesh	σάρξ sarx , sarx; this "sarx" is in reference to the positive or reality of our nature or stripped down to humanity = flesh.

OUR SPECIAL WEAPONS AND TACTICS You Are Engaged In A Supernatural War

we do not war according to the flesh.

war	στρατεύομαι strateuomai, <i>strat-yoo´-om-ahee;</i> to serve in a military campaign, to contend with carnal-worldly inclinations.
flesh	σάρξ sarx, sarx; this "sarx" is referring to the negative or un-reality of our nature. That our humanity, this mortal flesh is powerless.

2 Tim. 2:3-4

You therefore must endure hardship as a good soldier of Jesus Christ. 4 No one engaged in warfare entangles himself with the affairs of this life, that he may please him who enlisted him as a soldier.

OUR SPECIAL WEAPONS AND TACTICS You Are Engaged In A Supernatural War

For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God

weapons	οπλον hop'lon, root meaning for the Hoplite, a Greek citizen-solider. The hop'lon were offensive weapons of war designed for advancing.
warfare	στρατεία strateia , <i>strat-i´-ah</i> ; a protracted military campaign, a long-term military operation. A campaign until the end.

mighty

δυνατός **dunatos**, *doo-nat-os´;* powerful-enough, capable-enough, able-enough, power-enough, strong-enough

Eph. 6:10-12

Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. 11 Put on the whole armor of God, THAT YOU MAY BE ABLE to stand against the wiles of the devil. 12 For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places.

The Christian In Complete Armor

By William Gurnell

"Note the sharpness of this mortal combat. It is the kind of combat which the Christian's state is here set out by, Here the phrase "For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God" Tells us that our warring is of a wholly different sort than the wars fought in this world. The battles of this world employ implements of war that can be seen and heard. The spiritual war for the Christian is a war against a world that is evil, dark, a world at war with God and the powers behind our enemy have nothing else to do but to scheme and to attack."

Invisible (most of the time) **Spiritual beings not of this world**

Eph. 6:13-18

Therefore take up the whole armor of God, THAT YOU MAY BE ABLE to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. :14 Stand therefore, having (#1) girded your waist with truth, having (#2) put on the breastplate of righteousness, 15 and (#3) having shod your feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace; 16 (#4) above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one. 17 And (#5) take the helmet of salvation, and (#6) the SWORD of the Spirit, which is the word of God; 18 (#7) praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints.

Sword

μάχαιρα machaira, makh´-ahee-rah; a specific weapon of the centurion for engaged, hand to hand combat. designed to a length of approx. 18" for confirmed lethality.

Use The Bible Very Specifically – Not Generically

Psalm 119:11

Your word (the sword of the Spirit) I have hidden in my heart, That I might not sin against You.

Examples of This – Joseph in Egypt. Daniel in Babylon, Jesus in the Wilderness
