Heaven, Eternity, Paradise,

Revelation 22:3-7

:3 And there shall be no more curse, but the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it, and His servants shall serve Him. 4 They shall see His face, and His name shall be on their foreheads. 5 There shall be no night there: They need no lamp nor light of the sun, for the Lord God gives them light. And they shall reign forever and ever. :6 Then he said to me, "These words are faithful and true." And the Lord God of the holy pro-phets sent His angel to show His servants the things which must shortly take place. :7 "Behold, I am coming quickly! Blessed is he who keeps the words of the prophecy of this book."

When you hear the word "heaven" what comes to mind?

We use the word Heaven to describe things that are beyond wonderful or of exceptional beautiful or excellent delight. To be in "heaven" is to say that I am in a state of bliss or nirvana.

Better yet – when we look to the Bible, the word "Heaven" is mentioned 327 times in the Old Testament and 255 in the New = 582 times.

But even more than that is the fact that Heaven is either spoken of or referred to over 1,000 times in the Bible.

As a Counterpoint;

I find it comforting that the word "Hell" is only mentioned 31 times in the Old Testament and only 23 times in the New testament = Just 54 times. (but Jesus mentions it more than anyone else)

What is meant when we hear or use the word heaven?

The Bible in the original languages breaks down in perfect detail what is meant by the word heaven based upon the context in the actual word used to describe it.

"Who Told You About Heaven ?" 6.) What has God said about the heaven(s) ?

With some 582 mentions by name and over 1,000 reference of Heaven - - it is obviously very important to God.

There are three (3) distinct definitions of "Heaven" that appear in the Bible.

I like to think of the division this way; there is the **here**. There is the **up there** and there is the **outta here**

There is our (1) Immediate heavens which is our atmosphere or atmospheric exposure (2) Celestial or outer space which is the sun, moon, and stars) (3) The Abode or the Dwelling Place of God.

The Bumper Sticker; **"Everybody what's to go to heaven, but nobody wants to die"** (so true – that's another reason why rapture of the church is such a beautiful thing)

6a.) There is the Heaven of here and now

(1) Our immediate heavens which is our atmosphere For example the Bible says in the book of Genesis in the beginning God created the heaven and the earth (singular)

> **Genesis 1:1** In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.

This Immediate Heaven is earth's Atmosphere is the Troposphere. (30,000 ft. and below)

Here the Space Shuttle Endeavour is silhouetted against the atmosphere. The orange layer is the troposphere, the white layer is the stratosphere, and the blue layer is the mesosphere. The shuttle and Satellites and KJU's Nuclear ICBM's travel into Space at altitudes 100 to 200 miles high - far above all three layers.)

the heaven heb: shaw-mah '-yim

both the visible and beyond visible sky. the word means – that which is "aloft" from the immediate atmosphere belonging to the (foggy-air to the arch continuing upward to the celestial lights (stars) or bodies or the astrological heaven(s) or space.

(that would encompass from sea-elevation to the farthest observable stars)

"The WISE image of the Milky Way bulge shows that the X-shaped nature of the Milky Way bulge is self-evident and irrefutable," writing in a paper published this week in the Astronomical Journal.

"The X-shape morphology of the bulge in itself and the fraction of "bulge stars" that comprise orbits within this structure has important implications regarding the history of the Milky Way and all other spiral galaxies in general." Prof. Luke Davies of the International Centre for Radio Astronomy Research, said

the data was "reasonably compelling."

"You can clearly see the structure is there, whether or not there is a true X-shaped structure at the center of the Milky Way is under consideration."

(of course it's not an X-Shape – It's a Cross-Shape)

In his book "God and the Astronomers, NASA Astrophysicist And Director of the Goddard Space Center – Dr. Robert Jastrow,

"For the scientist who has lived by his faith in the power of reason, the story ends like a bad dream. He has scaled the mountains of ignorance, he is about to conquer the highest peak; as he pulls himself over the final rock, he is greeted by a band of theologians who have been sitting there for centuries."

The heavens (shaw-mah'-yim) declare (saw-far = tally, mark, check off, count) the glory of God; and the firmament (raw-kee-ah = atmosphere meets space) **shows (**naw-gad = reveal, expose, message, tell, rehearse) His handiwork. (to leave the evidence or finger prints or dna at the scene)
