For this reason we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to ask that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; **10** that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God 11 strengthened with all might, according to His glorious power, for all patience and longsuffering with joy; 12 giving thanks to the Father who has qualified us to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in the light. 13 He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love, 14 in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins.

Shepherd **grk:** poimaino; **to do what shepherds** do for sheep. (act like the shepherd) to shadow the shepherd as he cares, protects, presides over, watches out for, correcting. (the word demands a hands-on approach to shepherding the flock. The structure requires that the shepherd(s) be alert, vigilant, standing guard over the flock – against perpetual dangers that abound)

The Kings James Version puts it right

1 Peter 5:2 Feed / Shepherd the flock of God which is among you,

Jeremiah 3:15

And I will give you shepherds according to My heart, who will **feed you with** knowledge and understanding.

A New Testament Reality of This is...

1 Corinthians 9:16

For if I preach the gospel, I have nothing to boast of, for necessity is laid upon me; yes, woe is me if I do not preach the gospel!

All the shepherds activity falls under FEEDING.

"Feeding" Means Feeding Them Doctrine.

Feeding them "all things bible"

1 Corinthians 4:15-16

For though you might have ten thousand instructors in Christ, yet you do not have many fathers; for in Christ Jesus I have begotten you through the gospel. **16** Therefore I urge you, **imitate me.**

...and church history is replete with truly wonderful and

awe-inspiring examples of men and women of God who have changed the world for Christ.

Such As The Early Church Fathers

Clement of Rome / Polycarp of Smyrna / Justin / Irenaeus / Augustine

William Wilberforce - Did you know that it was **William Wilberforce**, a Christian, who eventually put an end to the slave trade of Great Britain. William Wilberforce (1759-1833) was a Christian abolitionist who also served as a member of England's House of Commons. Wilberforce campaigned tirelessly for the abolition of slavery beginning in 1789. Forty-four years later, just before his death, he learned that Parliament passed the Abolition Act, by which 700,000 slaves were set free.

Telemachus, a Christian in Rome, on New Years Day January 1st. 404, went to the Coliseum in Rome and for the first time witnessed the Gladiatorial Games as one man slew another to death. **Telemachus** was so offended and enraged by the human carnage that he jumped down onto the arena and ran between two gladiators – stopping them where they stood and pleading with them he said; *"This is not right. This cannot be right. This will never be right. Stop now this murdering."* It is unclear if the crowd or the gladiators proceeded to kill him but he was killed in his attempt to stop the killing. *When the Rome emperor saw what had happened, he was so moved by his conscience that he ended the Gladiatorial Games forever.*

William Carey was born on the 17th of August 1761. Carey, would become known as the "father of the modern missionary". He was a minister of the Gospel, translator of the Bible, social reformer and cultural anthropologist who himself founded the Serampore College and the Serampore University, the first degree-awarding university in India. He put an end to the practice of Sati (Sau'ttee), which is the Hindu practice that requires the death of the wife upon the death of her husband. Most often the practice was by burning.

But The Bible Warns Us About "Bad Examples"

Philippians 3:18-19

For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, that they are the enemies of the cross of Christ: 19 whose end is destruction, (why are they?) whose god is their belly, and whose glory is in their shame who set their mind on earthly things.

(2 Peter 2:1)

"There were also false prophets among the people, just as there will be false teachers among you."

Jude 1:4,10-11

4 For certain men have crept in unnoticed, who long ago were marked out for this condemnation, ungodly men, who turn the grace of our God into lewdness ... But these speak evil of whatever they do not know; and whatever they know naturally, like brute beasts, in these things they corrupt themselves. 11 Woe to them! For they have gone in the way of Cain, have run greedily in the error of Balaam for profit and perished in the rebellion of Korah.

There is a greediness about them. There is a sense of entitlement in them. There is an insatiable hunger to possess – always to possess!

Ezekiel 34:1-2,10

The word of the Lord came to me: **2** "Son of man, prophesy against the shepherds of Israel; prophesy and say to them: 'This is what the Sovereign Lord says: Woe to you shepherds of Israel who only take care of yourselves! Should not shepherds take care of the flock? **3** You eat the curds, clothe yourselves with the wool and slaughter the choice animals, but you do not take care of the flock. **10** This is what the Sovereign Lord says: I am against the shepherds and will hold them accountable for my flock.

1 Timothy 4:1-2

Now the Spirit expressly says that in latter times some will depart from the faith, giving heed to deceiving spirits and doctrines of demons, **2** speaking lies in hypocrisy, having their own conscience seared with a hot iron,

2 Timothy 2:1-2

You therefore, my son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus. **2** And the things that **you have heard from me among many witnesses**, (the example) commit these to faithful men who will be able to teach others also.

There is an indelible image I have in my mind. There is no greater ministry-example than this:

Acts 20:17-28

From Miletus he (Paul) sent to Ephesus and called for the elders of the church. 18 And when they had come to him, he said to them: "You know, from the first day that I came to Asia, in what manner I always lived among you, 19 serving the Lord with all humility, with many tears and trials which happened to me by the plotting of the Jews; 20 how I kept back nothing that was helpful, but proclaimed it to you, and taught you publicly and from house to house, 21 testifying to Jews, and also to Greeks, repentance toward God and faith toward our Lord Jesus Christ. 22 And see, now I go bound in the spirit to Jerusalem, not knowing the things that will happen to me there, 23 except that the Holy Spirit testifies in every city, saying that chains and tribulations await me. 24 But none of these things move me; nor do I count my life dear to myself, so that I may finish my race with joy, and the ministry which I received from the Lord Jesus, to testify to the gospel of the grace of God. :25 "And indeed, now I know that you all, among whom I have gone preaching the kingdom of God, will see my face no more. 26 Therefore I testify to you this day that I am innocent of the blood of all men. 27 For I have not shunned to declare to you the whole counsel of God. 28 Therefore **take heed to yourselves and to all the flock**, among which the Holy Spirit has made you **overseers**, to **shepherd** the church of God which He purchased with His own blood.

The Christian (minister) is to "Be Like" or, if you will, "Pretend" that we are just like Jesus in the Ministry. Being a little Jesus Christ, like the original, to others. (imitators)

1 John 4:17 Love has been perfected among us in this: that we may have boldness in the day of judgment; because as He is, so are we in this world.

This is to be **Our Motive** for Doing Anything / Everything. It is the "WHEN" factor of the Lord's return. In Hebrews 13, He Is The Great Shepherd who rose from the dead.

Here in 1 Peter 5:4, He Is The Chief Shepherd who is returning.

3c.) Our example is the reward

vs. 4b

4b you (the pastors. overseers, elders) will receive the crown of glory that does not fade away.

The "Always There Thought" in the Christian Mind is that Jesus Christ, The Chief Shepherd is About to Appear – So be Active & Finishing things up

There is a **Crown of Glory** that will be given.

Theologian Alexander Maclaren writes:

The **stephanos**, or Crown of Glory, was that crown which signified one as being of a royal or exalted rank. The **stephanos** was the wreath or garland which was given as a prize to victors in Greek and Roman public games.

The **stephanos** is the recognition given by Jesus Christ as a prize to the genuine servant of God. The **stephanos** crown (wreath) will be the reward to those who did righteousness. Their desire and faithfulness to honor Christ is rewarded by Christ.

Matthew 6:20-21

But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys and where thieves do not break in and steal. **21** For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.
