THE TITLE OF THE MESSAGE:

“Look What You’ve Become”

Living Out and Defending a Faith that is Unwavering, Resilient and Effective against the vain and senseless arguments of this godless age.

2 Peter 1:1-4

:1 Simon Peter, a **bondservant** and **apostle** of **Jesus Christ**, to those who have **obtained like precious faith** with us **by the righteousness of our God and Savior Jesus Christ**:

:2 **Grace** and **peace** be **multiplied** to you in the **knowledge** of **God** and of **Jesus** our **Lord**, **:3** as His **divine power** has **given** to us **all things** that **pertain** to **life** and **godliness**, **through** the **knowledge** of Him who **called us** **by glory** and **virtue**,

:4 **by** which **have been given** to us **exceedingly great** and **precious promises**, that **through these** you may be **partakers** of the **divine nature**, **having escaped** the **corruption** that is in the world **through lust**.

Date and Place:

1st. Peter had been writing in **63ad**. Peter now is compelled to write again a second time in **66ad**. from Rome where just shortly after writing this epistle – Peter would be crucified inverted and buried in Rome.

The Times:

False teachers had arisen with direct attacks against Christianity. They attacked (1) the Transfiguration of Christ, (2) The Inspiration of Scripture and (3) The Physical person of Jesus Christ. They attacked His Deity and they attacked the doctrine of the Physical, Second coming of Jesus Christ to earth.

Theme:

Combat Faith = Living Out and Defending a Faith that is Unwavering, Resilient and Effective against the vain and senseless arguments of this godless age.

Peter is all about “True and Accurate Knowledge” regarding The Ministry / The Person / Deity of Jesus of Nazareth.

The Audience:

The flock of God, is as it was in 1^{st.} Peter, the universal church of the 1^{st.} century.
Naturally, it had become the target of Emperor Newson
and those of an Antichrist system.

I can only imagine Peter's intensity

as he warns the believers of the oncoming flood of error, false doctrines and
coming apostasy which was about to sweep over Christendom.

Some years have now past since his writing of 1 Peter,
There is an Expected Growth and Maturity that would have taken place in the
lives of Peter's scattered congregation!

Authorship:

Peter writes to us concerning his passion and care for the true doctrines of God.
(an almost radical & total departure from 1-Peter in style, structure & language)

STRESSING TRANSFORMATION

The governing power over your life - which is it?

**You are being fashioned by your life lived today.
That truth is true regarding your past, present and future.**

Bondservant grk: doulos; a willful slave. Not only of your master, but of your own
decision making – to take your “enslavement” to the extreme.

Apostle grk: apostolos; a messenger, one sent on a mission

Combined It Means = that we decided to be willful, deliberate messengers of the
Gospel of Jesus Christ to the world.

**The reality is - if God is at work in your life,
Then you will be able to see a notable change in your life.**

Galatians 6:7-10

Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, that he will also reap. 8 For he who sows to his flesh will of the flesh reap corruption, but he who sows to the Spirit will of the Spirit reap everlasting life. 9 And let us not grow weary while doing good, for in due season we shall reap if we do not lose heart. 10 Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all, especially to those who are of the household of faith.

Peter, A Senior Fellow from The University of Hard Knocks

had learned this SUBMISSION from his experience –
Just like you and I are learning now.

Example of willful Enslavement:

- A Mother's Joy of Being Enslaved to the Nurturing of Her Child.
- A Husband's Joy of Being Enslaved to Loving His wife.
- A Father's Joy of Being Enslaved to the Welfare of His Family.
- A Wife's Joy of Being Enslaved to the Companionship of Her Husband.

:1b to those who have **obtained like precious faith**
with us **by the righteousness...**

obtained lagchano; to obtain by lot, cast lots, chosen, received.

To possess or to own or to have within your grasp;
The exact same faith as all others

precious grk: isotimos; held in high and equal honor of the same kind. That which is of infinite worth and value. (***The picture is that of a slave carrying an object of infinite and extreme worth from one place to another***)

faith grk: pistis; from 3982; faith, faithfulness. Proof. Evidence.

Salvation Faith is in Mind, but not only **Salvation Faith**.

Peter is Speaking of a **Faith that has Moved On and Out into Deeper Water, Deeper Experiences and Deeper Devotion.**
