Thus also faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead. :18 ¶ But someone will say, "You have faith, and I have works." Show me your faith without your works, and I will show you my faith by my works. :19 You believe that there is one God. You do well. Even the demons believe—and tremble! :20 But do you want to know, O foolish man, that faith without works is dead?

APPLYING FAITH TO THE WORD OF THE LORD

1a.) To believe in Him when He speaks

Judges 6:33-35

Then all the Midianites and Amalekites, the people of the East, gathered together; and they crossed over and encamped in the Valley of Jezreel. :34 But the Spirit of the LORD came upon Gideon;

Gideon went from threshing wheat while hiding in winepress to standing up and blowing a trumpet

God's Word is sure

immovable and steadfast. It's all powerful and blessed of God.

Jude 20

But you, beloved, building yourselves up on your most holy faith, (building up = stack, mount, lay up one atop the other)

These would be "Faith Events" in Your Life

Romans 10:17

So then faith *comes* by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

APPLYING FAITH TO THE WORD OF THE LORD

1b.) To obey Him in what He has asked

then he blew the trumpet, and the A-biaz-rites **gathered** behind him. **:35** And he sent messengers throughout all Manasseh (Gideon's tribe and people)

An Oft Misunderstood Verse

Matthew 17:20

for assuredly, I say to you, if you have faith as a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you.

(if the Lord is leading you to move mountains, move em')

faith is not used to do what we want, it's used to enable us to do what God wants

Hebrews 5:12-14

For though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need *someone* to teach you again the first principles of the oracles of God; and you have come to need milk and not solid food. :13 For everyone who partakes *only* of milk *is* unskilled in the word of righteousness, for he is a babe. :14 But solid food belongs to those who are of full age, *that is*, those who **by reason of use** have their senses **exercised** to discern both good and evil.

1c.) To rest in what He has said

Isaiah 53:11

He shall see the labor of His soul, *and* be satisfied. By His knowledge My righteous Servant shall justify many, For He shall bear their iniquities.

2c.) We must actively serve Him

v.37

then I shall know that You will save Israel by my hand, as You have said."

If (since) the Lord has Spoken what has happened to you, with you, by you?

Romans 12:1

I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service.

can we pretend for a moment?

3.) Is confirming the will of the Lord

v. 38-40

3a.) The Lord will be clear

v.38

And it was so. When he rose early the next morning and squeezed the fleece together, he wrung the dew out of the fleece, a bowlful of water.

Our Confidence in God will rise even in the face of opposition

how can we "Get Confirmation" in troubling times

Do You Have Confirmation / Confidence in the direction that you're going tonight?

3b.) The Lord will be patient

v.39

Then Gideon said to God, "Do not be angry with me, but let me speak just once more: Let me test, I pray, just once more with the fleece; let it now be dry only on the fleece, but on all the ground let there be dew

He is Patient
He is encouraging and He is fathering...

Notice That Gideon Didn't Sit Idle

This Kind of Caution, Blesses The Lord because the Lord knows that Gideon is going to Act.

Like a Parent with a Child at The Doctors Office – shot time!

3c.) The Lord will be gracious

v.40

And God did so that night. It was dry on the fleece only, but there was dew on all the ground.
