Statement of Textual Summation and Theme

Judges 7:1-15

Then Jerubbaal (that is, Gideon) and all the people who were with him rose early and encamped beside the well of Harod, so that the camp of the Midianites was on the north side of them by the hill of Moreh in the valley. :2 And the LORD said to Gideon, "The people who are with you are too many for Me to give the Midianites into their hands, lest Israel claim glory for itself against Me, saying, 'My own hand has saved me.' :3 Now therefore, proclaim in the hearing of the people, saying, "Whoever is fearful and afraid, let him turn and depart at once from Mount Gilead.' " And twenty-two thousand of the people returned, and ten thousand remained. :4 But the LORD said to Gideon, "The people are still too many; bring them down to the water, and I will test them for you there. Then it will be, that of whom I say to you, "This one shall go with you,' the same shall go with you; and of whomever I say to you, 'This one shall not go with you,' the same shall not go: 5 So he brought the people down to the water. GIDEON'S CONFIDENCE WOULD BE IN THE LORD

1a.) a future based upon where he stood v.1

Then Jerub-baal (that *is*, Gideon) and all the people who *were* with him rose early and encamped beside the well of Harod, so that the camp of the Midianites was on the north side of them by the hill of Moreh in the valley.

the **Baal** Fighter or Troubler

the Christian is to be a Satan Fighter or Troubler

How? - Seeing more Clearly, Spiritually, Long Term.

right now you're involved in a spiritual battle

1b.) God's word is not bound by physics

v.2

And the LORD said to Gideon, "The people who *are* with you *are* too many for Me to give the Midianites into their hands, lest Israel claim glory for itself against Me, saying, 'My own hand has saved me.

1c.) A call to excellence

v.3

Now therefore, proclaim in the hearing of the people, saying, "Whoever *is* fearful and afraid, let him turn and depart at once from Mount Gilead.' "And twenty-two thousand of the people returned, and ten thousand remained.

2.) Gideon's authority would be established

v.4-7

2a.) Through faith and obedience

v.4

:4 But the LORD said to Gideon, "The people *are* still *too* many; bring them down to the water, and I will **test** them for you there. Then it will be, *that* of whom I say to you, "This one shall go with you," the same shall go with you; and of whomever I say to you, 'This one shall not go with you,' the same shall not go."

GIDEON'S AUTHORITY WOULD BE ESTABLISHED

2b.) By being a leader God's way

v.5

:5 So he brought the people down to the water. And the LORD said to Gideon, "Everyone who laps from the water with his tongue, as a dog laps, you shall set apart by himself; likewise everyone who gets down on his knees to drink."

As Gideon follows, others are effected and influenced by him.

"Everyone who laps from the water with his tongue, as a dog laps,"

"drinks like a dog drinks" defensive and alert, ready to run, on the mark.

GIDEON'S AUTHORITY WOULD BE ESTABLISHED

2c.) Discernment by observation

v.6-7

:6 And the number of those who lapped, putting their hand to their mouth, was three hundred men; but all the rest of the people got down on their knees to drink water. :7 Then the LORD said to Gideon, "By the three hundred men who lapped I will save you, and deliver the Midianites into your hand. Let all the other people go, every man to his place."

3.) Gideon's victory would be complete

v.8-11

3a.) The Lord never loses a battle

v.8-9

:8 So the people took provisions and their trumpets in their hands. And he sent away all the rest of Israel, every man to his tent, and retained those three hundred men. Now the camp of Midian was below him in the valley. :9 It happened on the same night that the LORD said to him, "Arise, go down against the camp, for I have delivered it into your hand.

GIDEON'S VICTORY WOULD BE COMPLETE

3b.) The Lord always encourages us

v.10-11a

But if you are **afraid** to go down, go down to the camp with **Purah** your servant, **:11** and you shall hear what they say; and afterward your hands shall be **strengthened** to go down against the camp."

The Lord Provides Fellowship in the Crisis.

Wait, Why Not Just Remove the Fear, God?

GIDEON'S VICTORY WOULD BE COMPLETE

3c.) The Lord is our continuous victory

v.11b

...Then he went down **with Purah** his servant to the outpost of the armed men who *were* in the camp.

Gideon was Afraid – that doesn't prevent God from working, He makes provisions for Gideon's Fear.

4.) Gideon's reality would be in the promises v.12-15

4a.) The Lord would intervene

v.12-13

:12 Now the Midianites and Amalekites, all the people of the East, were lying in the valley as numerous as locusts; and their camels were without number, as the sand by the seashore in multitude. :13 And when Gideon had come, there was a man telling a dream to his companion. He said, "I have had a dream: To my surprise, a loaf of barley bread tumbled into the camp of Midian; it came to a tent and struck it so that it fell and overturned, and the tent collapsed

when God intervenes

He sends a global flood.

He sends fire out of heaven on Sodom and Gomorrah.

He parts the **Red Sea** and drowns the Egyptians

"a loaf of barley bread tumbled"

If you had a situation that needed the Lords intervention, what would you expect to see ?

GIDEON'S REALITY WOULD BE IN THE PROMISES

4b.) The Lord would prepare

v.14

Then his companion answered and said, "This is nothing else but the sword of Gideon the son of Joash, a man of Israel! Into his hand God has delivered Midian and the whole camp."

The Lord Desires to Do a Radical, Lasting, Powerful Thing in your life. There are no spectator Christians...

Daniel 11:32b

...but the people who know their God shall be strong, and carry out *great exploits*.

4c.) The Lord would use Gideon

v.15

And so it was, when Gideon <u>heard the telling of the dream and its interpretation</u>, **that he worshiped**. He returned to the camp of Israel, and said, "Arise, for the LORD has delivered the camp of Midian into your hand."

A WARNING TO AMERICA TODAY

The Lord had told Israel that if they honored Him and obeyed Him that He would put fear into the hearts of Israel enemies...

Deuteronomy 11:24-25

Every place on which the sole of your foot treads shall be yours: from the wilderness and Lebanon, from the river, the River Euphrates, even to the Western Sea, shall be your territory. :25 No man shall be able to stand against you; the LORD your God will put the dread of you and the fear of you upon all the land where you tread, just as He has said to you.

"Worshipped"

I personally believe that Heaven is Going to Filled with Worshippers. I also believe that those who are going to heaven are "Worshippers" in practice now.
