Giving Yourself to God

"I love the very nature and character of Our God, The Lord God of the Bible, YHWH is Inviting."

:1 Now (or then – kjv) Samson went to Gaza and saw a harlot there, and went in to her. :2 When the Gazites were told, "Samson has come here!" they surrounded the place and lay in wait for him all night at the gate of the city. They were quiet all night, saying, "In the morning, when it is daylight, we will kill him."

- 1. not knowing how much time has passed, Samson goes to Gaza.
- 2. and here we go again, Samson has selective vision girls!
- 3. the men waited to attack... but then verse 3 happens!

:3 And Samson lay *low* till midnight; then he arose at midnight, took hold of the doors of the gate of the city and the two gateposts, pulled them up, bar and all, put *them* on his shoulders, and carried them to the top of the hill that faces Hebron.

Samson's the catch of the day, bound, under guard, and chained

He walks away with the Strongest Part of the City — It's Gates!

:4 Afterward it happened that he loved a woman in the Valley of Sorek, (the valley of the choice red grape) whose name was Delilah. (to make poor, to steal)

He shouldn't be falling in love with a pagan woman. — remember why?

(because believers are not to marry unbelievers)

2 Corinthians 6:14-16

Do not be unequally yoked together with unbelievers. For what fellowship has righteousness with lawlessness? And what communion has light with darkness? :15 And what accord has Christ with Belial? Or what part has a believer with an unbeliever? :16 And what agreement has the temple of God with idols? For you are the temple of the living God.

He shouldn't be in this valley — remember why? (he was a nazarite)

:4 Afterward it happened that he loved a woman in the Valley of Sorek, (the valley of the choice red grape)

He shouldn't be with a Delilah — why?

(her name means one who robs or makes another poor)

There Are Some Places That Christians Have No Business Going To.

1 Corinthians 10:13-14

No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God *is* faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear *it*. **:14** Therefore, my beloved, flee from idolatry.

Samson Seems to Fumble from One Victory to Another Defeat.

his name appears 36 times in the bible, not always in a good light, not always in a bad way...

Yet The Last Mention of His Name is What Matters...

Hebrews 11:32

And what more shall I say? For the time would fail me to tell of Gideon and Barak and Samson and Jephthah, also *of* David and Samuel and the prophets:

1 Corinthians 6:20

For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's.

GIVING YOURSELF TO GOD

9a.) Know the value of who you really are

the value of human life is paramount in scripture.

THE TRUTH IS;

THE GREATER THE UNDERSTANDING WE HAVE OF GOD,
THE GREATER SELF-WORTH YOU'LL POSSESS.

Genesis 1:27

So God created man in His *own* **image**; in the **image** of God He created him; **male** and **female** He created them.

he made us having his moral likeness. and he made us different enough to recreate

John 17:23

I in them, and You in Me; that they may be made perfect in one, and that the world may know that You have sent Me, **and have loved them as You have loved Me.** – **THE SAME magnitude OF LOVE**

the uniqueness of the human being ...and then there's "you"!

the very specific "fingerprints" of God are upon you, for:

You're Worth Having:

1 Corinthians 6:19

Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit *who is* in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own?

You're Worth Keeping:

John 10:27-29

My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me. **:28** And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand. **:29** My Father, who has given *them* to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch *them* out of My Father's hand.

9b.) Picking your friends carefully

you will gravitate toward those who "**look**" like you. and I don't mean physically.

9c.) Having a worthy goal in sight

2 Chronicles 34:33

Thus Josiah removed all the abominations from all the country that *belonged* to the children of Israel, and made all who were present in Israel diligently serve the LORD their God. All his days they did not depart from following the LORD God of their fathers.

1 Corinthians 9:24-26

Do you not know that those who run in a race all run, but only one receives the prize? Run in such a way that you may win. :25 And everyone who competes in the games exercises self-control in all things. They then do it to receive a perishable wreath, but we an imperishable. :26 Therefore I run in such a way, as not without aim; I box in such a way, as not beating the air;

As a Christian our standards & performance ought to be the very best.

- 1. start with a goal that's "just bigger" than you.
- 2. then move to the "next" goal.
- 3. and "then" the next goal.

don't settle for something common, rather "use" what's common as a stepping stone.

HOW DO I SET A GOAL FOR MY LIFE?

- (1) determine what your interests are
- (2) ask God to confirm that interest from His Word
- (3) pray asking Him for the opportunity to do that thing
- (4) prioritize it in your life
- (5) develop it to the best ability possible
- (6) use it to the glory of God and not yourself

KEEPING YOURSELF FOR GOD

9d.) Expecting your plans to be oppossed

things that are "different" are misunderstood in life.

we are fighting a spiritual enemy, very ancient, very wise! recognize "where" to keep yourself in life.

9e.) Keeping the Bible as your guide

but "how" does the word of God become my guide?

have you ever marinated meat?

it's the immersion, the soaking, the saturating part that heightens the taste,

Psalm 51:6

Your word I have hidden in my heart, That I might not sin against You.

what can I expect if I stand on the Bible?
