Let your conduct be without covetousness; be **content** with such things as you have. For He Himself has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you."

DISCONTENTMENT, n.

Webster defines it as - The state of being uneasy in mind; an uneasiness.

The Absence of contentment. to be unsettled or restless on mind and soul. A sense of being dissatisfied. A person unable to find rest, a comfortless individual.

The Timing of This is of God – It's Christmas !

Most of us, being human's - we're not living "in that place" that we were created to live in. We've been made to live in the presences of God.

We're kind of like that little boy who...

Listening to his dad pray, "father we now enter into your presents, we sense you presence Lord and we need your presents, so Lord please give us your presents" at that Johnny just could not take anymore of it and said – "when? When are we going to get these presents daddy?"

It is true that God made our original mom and dad perfect, we struggle with a distant connection with Adam and eve, that why we long for perfection and satisfaction and contentment. This is true because the world which once was, was said by God to be 'very good'.

Rom. 8:20

"For the creation was **subjected to futility**," (man and creation was instantly placed in a state or mode of death and decay)

The "Context" of Your Life Determines Whether Discontentment is bad or good.

But there are two sorts of discontentment. There is a spiritual discontentment and a carnal discontentment.

Prov. 27:20

Hell and Destruction are never full; So the eyes of man are never satisfied.

James 4:1-3

What causes fights and quarrels among you? Don't they come from your desires that battle within you? :2 You want something but don't get it. <u>You kill</u> <u>and covet, but you cannot have what you want.</u> You quarrel and fight. You do not have, because you do not ask God. :3 When you ask, you do not receive, because you ask with wrong motives, that you may spend what you get on your pleasures.

Then Judas, His betrayer, seeing that He had been condemned, was remorseful and brought back the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and elders, :4 saying, "I have sinned by betraying innocent blood." ¶ And they said, "What *is that* to us? There's a Great Emptiness & Frustration That is naturally connected to material things. (material things are not bad or evil – it's a heart issue)

2.) Recognize that physical discontentment can be good

1Sam. 22:1-2

David therefore departed from there and escaped to the cave of Adullam. So he became captain over them. And there were about four hundred men with him... (these all became David's mighty men of valor – Israeli Special Forces)
