Introduction to the Text;

Isaiah 12:1-6

Isaiah 12:1-3

(And) **in that day** you will say:

"O LORD, I will praise You; (1) Though You were angry with me, Your anger is turned away, and (2) You comfort me. 2 Behold, (3) God is my **salvation**, I will trust and not be afraid; (4) "For YAH, the LORD, is my strength and song; (5) He also has become my **salvation**." 3 Therefore (6) with joy you will draw water from the wells of **salvation**.

Isaiah 12:4-6

(And) **in that day** you will say:

"Praise the LORD, (7) call upon His name; (8) Declare His deeds among the peoples, (9) Make mention that His name is exalted. 5 (10) Sing to the LORD, For He has done excellent things; This is known in all the earth. 6 (11) Cry out and shout, O inhabitant of Zion, (12) For great is the Holy One of Israel in your midst!"

The hand of God had been receding from Israel in the north and **Judah** in the south as a well-deserved judgment is coming upon Isaiah and the nation. The enemy is closing in and they will be taken captive. The future doesn't look good for the people.

But the ultimate future for Israel will be glorious

In the short term, Israel is being re-gathered as a nation both ethnically and politically. According to the Bible, Israel must become the key, dominant issue (problem) among the nations of the world in the last days.

Presently, she is prospering as a nation and growing

And will continue to become a financial power-house in the region. But her success will be seen by other nations who will seek to invade, that will happen.

Israel will seek to have peace and sign an agreement

with the surrounding nations that, on paper, will guarantee a treaty of peace for 7 years. That treaty will be violated by its author, the Lawless One.

Jesus Christ, Israel's Messiah will return for her

In the awesome and violent Second Coming to earth.

Chapter 12 - is about her coming reality AFTER the Second Coming of Jesus

1.) We who have Him as our salvation vs. 1-3

Isaiah 12:1-3

(And) **in that day** you will say: "O LORD, I will praise You; ⁽¹⁾ Though You were angry with me, Your anger is turned away, and ⁽²⁾ You comfort me. 2 Behold, ⁽³⁾ God is my **salvation**, I will trust and not be afraid; ⁽⁴⁾ "For YAH, the LORD, is my strength and song; ⁽⁵⁾ He also has become my **salvation.**" 3 Therefore ⁽⁶⁾ with joy you will draw water from the wells of **salvation**.

WE WHO HAVE HIM AS OUR SALVATION

1a.) He is the One I have offended vs. 1a

"O LORD, I will praise **YOU**;

⁽¹⁾ Though **You** were angry with **me**, **Your** anger is turned away

1b.) He causes me to know His compassion vs. 1b

and ⁽²⁾ **You** comfort **me**.

1c.) He desires rest for my heart and soul vs. 2a

:2 Behold, ⁽³⁾ **God** is **my salvation**, **I will trust** and not be **afraid**;

afraid

due to unpredictability, one who flinches or shakes with fear.

WE WHO HAVE HIM AS OUR SALVATION

1d.) He gives what I could never have

vs. 2b

(4) "For YAH (LORD), the LORD (YAHOVAH), is my strength and song;

For YAH, the LORD is God.

Ye'shua is the Hebrew name for the English name Jesus or Joshua.
Ya'sus, "Jesus" in the Greek transliteration of His name.
Jesus or Joshua or Ye'ho'shua have the same meaning.

Acts 7:45 KJV

Which also our fathers that came after brought in with Jesus (Ihsouvs Iesous) into the possession of the Gentiles, whom God drove out before the face of our fathers, unto the days of David.

Acts 7:45 NKJV

45 which our fathers, having received it in turn, also brought with Joshua into the land possessed by the Gentiles, whom God drove out before the face of our fathers until the days of David,

is my strength and song;

1e.) He becomes my very salvation

vs. 2c

(5) He also has become my salvation.

1f.) He provides endlessly for me

vs. 3

Therefore (6) with joy you will draw water from the wells of salvation.

2.) We who know Him by His Name

vs. 4-6

Isaiah 12:4-6

(And) in that day you will say:

"Praise the LORD, (7) call upon His name; (8) Declare His deeds among the peoples, (9) Make mention that His name is exalted. 5 (10) Sing to the LORD, For He has done excellent things; This is known in all the earth. 6 (11) Cry out and shout, O inhabitant of Zion, (12) For great is the Holy One of Israel in your midst!"

WE WHO KNOW HIM BY HIS NAME...

2a.) ...Is He who is near to us

vs. 4a

(And) in that day you will say:

"Praise the LORD, (7) call upon His name

2b.) ...Is He who has done wonders

vs. 4b

(8) Declare His deeds among the peoples, (inventions)

2c.) ...Is He who is mighty

vs. 4c

(9) Make mention that His name is exalted.

(to boast in the LORD)

2d.) ...Is He who glories over His creation

vs. 5a

(10) Sing to the LORD, For He has done excellent things; This is known in all the earth.

(loud, raging, massive, grand, majestic)

2e.) ...Is He who is worthy of our worship

vs. 6a

(11) Cry out and shout, O inhabitant of Zion,

2f.) ...Is He who the world one day see

vs. 6b

(12) For great is the Holy One of Israel in your midst!"

in **your** midst!"

when Jesus literally walks about Zion and sits upon His earthly throne
(personal relationship)
