Introduction to the Text; **Isaiah 30:1-33**

We all know John 3:16, **For God so loved...**

1John 4:8, **God is love...**

We also know that love is a characteristic that transcends any evolutionary claim or theme because – Love by nature is sacrificial, it doesn't take – it gives. It is an irreconcilable attribute that argues against the **“Survival of the Fittest”** rant of the evolutionist – Love, Rather, is the willful humbling of ones' self to the point of sacrificing ones self for another.

Love can be so powerful that it can bring the love of the lover for the loved to the point of extinction

John 15:12-13

This is My commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you. **13**

1.) He loves by refusing to tolerate our ways vv. 1-3

Isaiah 30:1-3

"Woe to the rebellious children," says the LORD, "Who take counsel, but not of Me, And who devise plans, but not of My Spirit, That they may add sin to sin; 2 Who walk to go down to Egypt, And have not asked My advice, To strengthen themselves in the strength of Pharaoh, And to trust in the shadow of Egypt! 3 Therefore the strength of Pharaoh Shall be your shame, And trust in the shadow of Egypt Shall be your humiliation.

Isaiah 30:1

Psalms 1:1-3

Blessed is the man Who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, Nor stands in the path of sinners, Nor sits in the seat of the scornful; 2 But his delight is in the law of the LORD, And in His law he meditates day and night. 3 He shall be like a tree Planted by the rivers of water, That brings forth its fruit in its season, Whose leaf also shall not wither; And whatever he does shall prosper.

**If you were about to be taken away from your family
and you had only one opportunity to give them advice, what would you say?**

John 17:8a

For I have given to them the words which You have given Me;
and they have received them,

John 17:14a

I have given them Your word;

Isaiah 8:19-20

Someone may say to you, "Let's ask the mediums and those who consult the spirits of the dead. With their whisperings and mutterings, they will tell us what to do." But shouldn't people ask God for guidance? Should the living seek guidance from the dead? :**20** Look to God's instructions and teachings! People who contradict his word are completely in the dark.
