## “The Ministry Of The Messiah – According To The Bible”

Discovering the Salvation of the Lord Jesus Christ in the Prophecies of Isaiah

### SUBJECT TOPICALLY REFERENCED UNDER:

**Israel, Jesus Christ, Servant, Messiah, King, Salvation**

Last time we saw that in chapter 51, God was reaching out to His Remnant people.

The LORD will always preserve His Remnant in the earth.

Many people today are concerned that - - the number of true Followers of Christ are growing slim.

This reality is true, And it is a biblical fact that this “Reduction” must happen in the Last Days.

### 1 Timothy 4:1 NLT

Now the Holy Spirit tells us clearly that in the last times some will turn away from the true faith; they will follow deceptive spirits and teachings that come from demons.

**But this is how you and I are to receive this warning;**

We’re to take heed. We’re to be on guard. Vigilant!

### Matthew 24:3-4

Now as He sat on the Mount of Olives, the disciples came to Him privately, saying, “Tell us, when will these things be? And what will be the sign of Your coming, and of the end of the age?” :4 And Jesus answered and said to them: “Take heed that no one deceives you.

### Acts 20:28-31

Therefore **take heed** to yourselves and to all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to **shepherd** the church of God (*feed them the word*) which He purchased with His own blood. 29 For I know this, that after my departure **savage wolves** will come in among you, not sparing the flock. 30 Also **from among yourselves men will rise up, speaking** perverse things, *their motive* **to draw away** the disciples after themselves. 31 Therefore **watch**, and **remember** that for three years I did not cease to **warn** everyone night and day with tears.

### Revelation 3:10-11

Because you have kept My command to persevere, I also will keep you from the hour of trial which shall come upon the whole world, to test those who dwell on the earth. 11 Behold, I am coming quickly!

**Hold fast what you have, that no one may take your crown.**

## He calls out to Israel's future and to the millennium age

### Isaiah 52:1-15

**Awake, awake!** put on your strength, O Zion; put on your beautiful garments, O Jerusalem, the holy city! For the uncircumcised and the unclean shall no longer come to you. 2 Shake yourself from the dust, arise; sit down, O Jerusalem! Loose yourself from the bonds of your neck, O captive daughter of Zion!

:3 For thus says the Lord: "You have sold yourselves for nothing, and **you shall be redeemed without money.**" :4 For thus says the Lord God: "My people went down at first into Egypt to dwell there; Then the Assyrian oppressed them without cause. 5 Now therefore, what have I here," says the Lord, "That My people are taken away for nothing? Those who rule over them make them wail," says the Lord, "and My name is blasphemed continually every day. 6 Therefore **My people shall know My name;** therefore they shall know in that day that I am He who speaks: "**Behold, it is I.**" "

## Here now in verse 7 is an amazing revelation concerning the One and Only Gospel of God.

### Verse 7

**7 How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of him who brings good news,** who proclaims **peace**, who brings **glad tidings** of good things, who proclaims **salvation**, who says to Zion, "your God reigns!"

Though all missionary work is in mind here, there are "Specifics" that are the main focus here.

### Daniel 12:3,10

Those who are wise shall shine like the brightness of the firmament, and those who turn many to righteousness like the stars forever and ever. :10 Many shall be purified, made white, and refined, but the wicked shall do wickedly; and none of the wicked shall understand, but the wise shall understand.

**This verse is exactly what Jesus would have referred the disciples to on the Road to Emmaus in Luke 24.**

**Genesis 3:15**

And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her **Seed**; He (the Seed) shall bruise (crush) your head, and you shall bruise (crush) His heel."

**Genesis 22:8**

And Abraham said, My son, **God will provide** *(for)* **Himself** a lamb for a burnt offering.

**The One & Only Gospel of God is His Eternal Gospel.**

**The Book of Revelation Chapter 14 says  
"It is the Everlasting Gospel"**

**Ephesians 1:3-5**

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who **has blessed** us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ, 4 just as He **chose** us in Him **before** the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love, 5 **having predestined** us to adoption as sons by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will.

**The Great Crime of Adding, Deleting or Replacing the Gospel**

**Galatians 1:8-9**

But even if we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel to you than what we have preached to you, let him be accursed. 9 As we have said before, so now I say again, if anyone preaches any other gospel to you than what you have received, let him be accursed.

**Verse 8-10**

8 Your watchmen *(for now they are to warn)* shall lift up their voices, with their voices they shall sing together; for they shall see eye to eye when the Lord brings back Zion. 9 Break forth into joy, sing together, You waste places of Jerusalem! For the Lord has comforted His people, He has redeemed Jerusalem. *(and this is how He is going to do it)* 10 The Lord has made bare His holy arm in the eyes of all the nations; and all the ends of the earth shall see the salvation of our God.

**Verse 11-12**

11 **Depart! Depart!** Go out from there, touch no unclean thing; go out from the midst of her, be clean, you who bear the vessels of the Lord. 12 For you shall not go out with haste, nor go by flight; for the Lord will go before you, and the God of Israel will be your rear guard.

**Here, Technically, Chapter 53 Begins;

# The Ministry of the Messiah According To The Bible

1.) The Messiah must suffer and die

vs. 13

## Verse 13

*(chapter 53 begins here)* **Behold, My Servant** shall deal **prudently**;  
He *(not Israel)* shall be **exalted** and **extolled** and be very **high**.

### **This is significant.**

Because it reveals to us the fact that God has a qualified representative that He refers to as “My Servant”.

And the word “**Behold**” here is an exhortation to all – that they should look to Him. That all attention is to be given to Him.

**“My Servant shall deal prudently;”**

( He would be known for His profound wisdom and discretion )

**He** *(personal pronoun - not Israel)* shall be **exalted**

( a negative connotation = to be lifted higher, raised up high, posted )

Implying that “**He** *(personal pronoun - not Israel)* shall be **extolled**“

( a negative connotation = to be put through the testing, through the fire, through the proving )

**He** *(personal pronoun - not Israel)* and will be **very high**

( an illusion to death or dying. to become a spectacle or an object of death )

## The Ministry of the Messiah

### **Daniel 9:24-27**

“Seventy weeks (490 years) are determined for your people and for your holy city, (1) to finish the transgression, (2) to make an end of sins, (3) to make reconciliation for iniquity, (4) to bring in everlasting righteousness, (5) to seal up vision and prophecy, and (6) to anoint the Most Holy. 25 “Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the command to restore and build Jerusalem until Messiah the Prince, there shall be seven weeks (49 years) and sixty-two weeks; the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublesome times. 26 “And after the sixty-two weeks Messiah shall be cut off, but not for Himself; and the people of the prince who is to come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary. The end of it shall be with a flood, and till the end of the war desolations are determined. 27 Then he shall confirm a covenant with many for one week; but in the middle of the week He shall bring an end to sacrifice and offering. And on the wing of abominations shall be one who makes desolate, even until the consummation, which is determined, is poured out on the desolate.”

## The Ministry of the Messiah According To The Bible

2.) The Messiah must be the Atonement

vs. 14

### Verse 14

Just as many were **astonished** at You, so His **visage** was **marred** more than any man, and His **form** more than the sons of men;

**Astonished**

**To be Appalled at, to be shocked at the sight of.**

**Visage**

**Human Appearance**

**Marred**

**Is to be destroyed to the point of not being able to be recognized.**

## The Ministry of the Messiah According To The Bible

3.) The Messiah must be the salvation of mankind

vs. 15

### Verse 15

So shall He **sprinkle** many nations. Kings shall **shut** their mouths at Him; for what had not been told them they shall **see**, and what they had not heard they shall **consider**.

**sprinkle**

**to gush, spurt, or to splash,**

**this speaks to the Ministry of His Priesthood**

**see Hebrews 8**
