Introduction to the Text; Isaiah 52:13-15

Isaiah 52:13-15

Behold, My Servant shall deal prudently; He shall be exalted and extolled and be very high. 14 Just as many were astonished at you, so His visage was marred more than any man, and His form more than the sons of men; 15 So shall He sprinkle many nations. Kings shall shut their mouths at Him; for what had not been told them they shall see, and what they had not heard they shall consider.

These verses speak exactly to what Jesus Christ Himself was referring to while walking on the Road to Emmaus in Luke 24.

Luke 24:25-27

Then He said to them, “O foolish ones, and slow of heart to believe in all that the prophets have spoken! **26** Ought not the Christ to have **suffered** these things and to enter into His **glory?**” **27** And beginning at **Moses** and **all then Prophets**, H expounded to them in **all the Scriptures** the things concerning Himself.

**Remember Now That Technically, Chapter 53 Begins;
The Ministry of the Messiah According To The Bible**

13 (*chapter 53 begins here*) Behold, My Servant shall deal **prudently**; He shall be **exalted** and **extolled** and be very **high**. **14** Just as many were **astonished** at you, so His **visage** was **marred** more than any man, and His **form** more than the sons of men; **15** So shall He **sprinkle** many nations. Kings shall shut their mouths at Him; for what had not been told them they shall see, and what they had not heard they shall consider.

The Ministry of the Messiah According To The Bible

1.) The Messiah must suffer and die vs. 13

Behold, My Servant shall deal **prudently**;
He (*not Israel*) shall be **exalted** and **extolled** and be very **high**.

This is significant.

Because here Isaiah is prophesying in bold terms and in a crystal clear fashion that Israel's Messiah, the world's Salvation would have to first be Qualified by Suffering –
The Suffering Servant.

(This Should Not Have Surprised Any Student of the Bible)

And the word “**Behold**” implies an Opportunity you have. Look. Turn your face toward Him. This is an exhortation to all that they should consider, ponder, muse upon Him.
That all attention is to be given to Him.

“And I will pour on the house of David and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem the Spirit of grace and supplication; then they will look on Me whom they pierced. Yes, they will mourn for Him as one mourns for his only son, and grieve for Him as one grieves for a firstborn.

The Suffering Ministry of the Messiah

Daniel 9:24-27

“Seventy weeks (490 years) are determined for your people and for your holy city, (1) to finish the transgression, (2) to make an end of sins, (3) to make reconciliation for iniquity, (4) to bring in everlasting righteousness, (5) to seal up vision and prophecy, and (6) to anoint the

Most Holy. 25 “Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the command to restore and build Jerusalem until Messiah the Prince, there shall be seven weeks (49 years) and sixty-two weeks; the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublesome times.
26a “And after the sixty-two weeks and **the Messiah** shall be **cut off**, but not for Himself.

2.) The Messiah must be the Atonement vs. 14

Just as many were **astonished** at You, so His **visage** was **marred** more than any man, and His **form** more than the sons of men;

Astonished
To be Appalled at, to be shocked at the sight of.

Visage
Human Appearance

Marred
Is to be destroyed to the point of not being able to be recognized.

3.) The Messiah must be the salvation of mankind vs. 15

So shall He **sprinkle** many nations. Kings shall **shut** their mouths at Him; for what had not been told them they shall **see**, and what they had not heard they shall **consider**.

sprinkle
to gush, spurt, or to splash,

This speaks to the Ministry of His Priesthood

Hebrews 9:11-14

But Christ came as High Priest of the good things to come, with the greater and more perfect tabernacle not made with hands, that is, not of this creation. **12** Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption. **13** For if the blood of bulls and goats and the ashes of a heifer, sprinkling the unclean, sanctifies for the purifying of the flesh, **14** how much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?
