We cannot know anything aright about ourselves unless we first begin to know what we can about the nature of God.

Does God exist? / Can I know that He does?
If God does exist, what is He like?
Why is there evil? / Why is there good?

To do that we must face the obvious.

There is the undeniable reality of both good and evil. There is no one or the other, there is only both. One exposes the existence of the other.

A word about our mental health community.

This is where we as a culture are prone to coming up short when it comes to diagnosing a person's mental and or emotional ills. Our system leaves out the ultimate treatment – dealing with the spiritual nature of man.

When we talk about **THE BODY** we are obviously talking about the material side of man. Our physical existence is what it is for the purpose of physical expression. Putting it bluntly - The human body is a tool, a biological machine, a physical apparatus.

When we talk about **THE SOUL** it is not so obvious to us although it should be. Our human soul is Part One of our Immaterial existence as well but a bit more.

In the Fall, our minds became corrupted (call it a virus) and it was no longer able to function as designed. We lost our ability to; (1) understand (2) to think clearly (3) to process (4) our minds became un-tied from the mind of God.

When we talk about **THE SPIRIT** we are talking the highest level of man's immaterial existence. Until a man is spiritually awakened, he cannot relate at all to the

The human spirit was originally the highest part of man, and the soul and the body were subject to it. Under normal conditions, the spirit is like the lady of a house, the soul is like the steward, while the body is like the servants. When the lady of the house needs something done, she charges the steward, and the steward in turn directs the servants to do it accordingly. The lady gives the order in private, while the servants take the order from the steward. Outwardly, the steward seems to be the master. But actually, the real master is the lady of the house. Unfortunately, man fell, failed, and sinned, so that the original, proper order of the spirit, soul, and body was overturned.

Like motoring—don't wait till the last moment before you put on the brakes but put them on, gently and quietly, while the danger is still a good way off."

When we think about what God is like we must realize that God is Spirit, more like a mind or consciousness than anything else.

"When a man is getting better, he understands more and more clearly the evil that is still left in him. When a man is getting worse, he understands his own badness less and less. A moderately bad man knows he is not very good: a thoroughly bad man thinks he is all right. This is common sense, really. You understand sleep when you are awake, not while you are sleeping. You can see mistakes in arithmetic when your mind is working properly: while you are making them you cannot see them. You can understand the nature of drunkenness when you are sober, not when you are drunk. Good people know about both good and evil: bad people do not know about either." C. S. Lewis
